ORDER NO. 1
CONTINUING PRELIMINARY HEARING

This matter is set for a preliminary hearing in Austin, Texas, at the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) facilities on March 26, 2020. Based on Governor Abbott's proclamation about COVID-19 and his letter to agencies recommending cancellation of non-essential travel and minimizing all non-essential in-person meetings, SOAH has cancelled or continued all non-emergency live hearings in Travis, Harris, and Dallas Counties through the end of March 2020.¹

It is therefore **ORDERED** that the preliminary hearing set for March 26, 2020, is **CONTINUED** to **May 7, 2020**, at the SOAH facilities in Austin, Texas.
