The SPRY program provides grants to replace or repower **drayage trucks or cargo handling equipment** operating at seaports and rail yards in Texas' nonattainment areas.

Who Can Apply?

Individuals and entities who have operated a drayage truck or cargo handling equipment at one or more of the designated seaports or rail yards for a minimum of 200 days per year for the preceding two years.

Grant Amounts

Receive up to **80%** of the cost to replace or repower your vehicle or equipment.

Equipment to be Replaced or Repowered

- Vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) over **26,000 lbs.**
- Yard trucks
- Heavy duty cargo handling equipment (container handlers, fork lifts, loaders, gantry cranes and more)



Eligible Areas

All sea ports and certain Class I rail yards in the state's nonattainment areas. Call us or visit terpgrants.org for the current list.
