

Texas Clean Fleet Program (TCFP) Grants Available!

About TCFP

The TCFP provides grants to replace 10 or more diesel-powered vehicles with alternative fuel or hybrid vehicles to entities that operate large fleets of vehicles in Texas. Call 1-800-919-TERP to see if you qualify! Or visit www.terpgrants.org.

Who Can Apply?

Individuals and entities who operate at least 75 vehicles in Texas. At least 10 of those vehicles must be diesel-powered.

Vehicles Eligible for Replacement

Light-duty and heavy-duty diesel vehicles that have been registered in Texas—and operated in the state for at least 75% of their annual usage—for at least the two years immediately preceding the grant round.

Vehicles Eligible for Purchase

A new vehicle that is the same type and general weight class as the old vehicle, is certified to the current federal emissions standard, and is powered by one of the following alternative fuel types:

- Electricity
- Compressed Natural Gas (CNG)
- Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG)
- Hydrogen
- Propane (LPG)
- Methanol, 85% by Volume (M85)

Grant Amounts

Receive up to 80% of the cost of purchasing the new vehicle.

Eligible Areas

Grants will be awarded to applicants who will operate their new vehicles in one or more of the Clean Transportation Zone counties:
