MS4 General Permit Stakeholder Meeting

March 2017 - The TCEQ will host a public stakeholder meeting to discuss the renewal of the 2018 Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Phase II MS4 General Permit No. TXR040000.

This general permit authorizes the discharge of stormwater and certain non-stormwater sources from small MS4s. The current permit expires on December 13, 2018.
