



**Figure 1: Number of NOV's**




**Figure 2: Number of Effective Orders**




**Figure 3: Assessed Penalties**

For fiscal year 2011 through January, TCEQ has:

- Issued 6,238 Notices of Violation
- Issued 481 Administrative Orders (see <http://www5.tceq.state.tx.us/eenf/>);
- Assessed \$5,464,198 in administrative penalties; and
- Approved 53 Supplemental Environmental Projects.
