Additional Information: The aquatic life use is fully supported. The fish consumption use was not assessed.

This water body was identified on the 2000 303(d) List as not supporting the contact recreation use due to bacteria. Because there were insufficient data available in 2002 to evaluate changes in water quality in the portion upstream of US 96, this water body will be identified as not meeting the standard for bacteria until sufficient data are available to demonstrate use support.
