RE: Notice of Fee Requirements Related to Annual Air Emissions and Inspection Fees

Dear Air Fees Contact:

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) is requesting that you submit a completed Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 Air Emissions/Inspection Fee Basis Form. Agency records indicate that your company owns or operates an account (site) that may be required to pay either the air inspection fee per 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §101.24 or the air emissions fee per 30 TAC §101.27.

If a site will be active for any portion of FY 2021 (September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2021) then one or both of these fees may apply. The inspection fee applies to sites operating under one of the listed standard industrial classification codes in 30 TAC §101.24; the emissions fee applies to sites subject to Title V permitting requirements. If both fees are applicable to a site, only the higher of these two fees will be assessed.

These fees are assessed and billed each FY; the next FY fee due is FY 2021. Based on the information reported in the fee form, the TCEQ will determine the applicable fee, fee amount, and will send the fee invoice in October 2020.¹ Please reference the enclosed form for more information.

Please complete and return the enclosed TCEQ Air Emissions/Inspection Fee Basis Form within 60 days from the date of this letter. To avoid TCEQ enforcement actions, the completed Air Emissions/Inspection Fee Basis Form must be submitted by the specified due date.
