**RACT Analysis for DFW 50-100 TPY Non-CTG/ACT Sources**

The 1990 FCAA Amendments require states to insure that Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) is in place for all major VOC sources in moderate and above ozone nonattainment areas. On March 20, 1998, the Dallas/Fort Worth (DFW) ozone nonattainment area, already targeted for RACT as a moderate area, was reclassified as a serious ozone nonattainment area. As a result, the major source definition for the area is being revised downward from 100 tons per year (TPY) to VOC sources 50 TPY and larger. The commission completed a RACT analysis for the DFW area, which demonstrated that VOC RACT requirements had been met for sources between 50 and 100 TPY in any of the Control Technique Guideline (CTG) or Alternative Control Technique (ACT) categories. This demonstration was submitted to the EPA as part of the proposed DFW Attainment Demonstration SIP.

The table below summarizes the RACT analysis for those sources between 50 and 100 TPY which are not covered by a CTG or ACT. The commission has confirmed that each of the identified sources has installed RACT level controls through compliance with an existing rule or with permitting requirements.
