RFGA

Item A. RFGA, Page iii, now reads:

Applications will be accepted for consideration during this grant period only if received on the premises of TCEQ (12100 Park 35 Circle, Austin, TX 78753) or via electronic mail to VWsettle@tceq.texas.gov by no later than 5:00 p.m. Central Standard Time, January 27, 2021. The award of the grant is dependent upon the availability of funding. Any changes will be made through an addendum posted to the Electronic System Business Daily (ESBD).

There will be no pre-proposal conference.

Item B. RFGA, Section 7.3, Page 12, now reads:

7.3 Deadline for Submission

Unless the acceptance of applications is suspended by the TCEQ prior to the application deadline, applications must be completed according to the application instructions and received on the premises of the TCEQ or via electronic mail to VWsettle@tceq.texas.gov by no later than 5:00 p.m. Central Time, January 27, 2021. Applications received in the TCEQ mail room on this date are not guaranteed to be delivered to Rm. 1301 by the required deadline, so applicants are encouraged to plan their submission accordingly. Applicants are encouraged to submit an application as early as possible.

The TCEQ may suspend acceptance and/or processing of applications at any time during the application period with no obligation to continue processing an otherwise eligible application received within the deadline through an addendum posted to the ESBD.
