Although I would love to see more charging stations in Brownsville, I think there might be a better option if you are looking for locations for charging stations.

There are only two roads in and out of this part of Texas. Those Highways are 281 from Mcallen and 69E out of Brownsville/Harlingen.

Neither of those have mid point charging stations. A charging station at the Rest area near Sarita Texas would allow cars to travel from Kingsville/Corpus Christi to Brownsville (very few EVs can do that now) . Also a charging station in Falfurrias would open up a corridor from Mcallen to Georgewest.

I recently bought an EV and had to have it shipped here because of the large gaps in charging stations. It is our third car so it is assumed that it will never leave the Valley. We would consider EVs as our main cars if there weren't charging deserts all around us.

Aside from being convenient this would also open up the market for more EVs.
