Dear Mr. Greene:

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has reviewed the *Final Report for Greene World Nozzle Replacement Parts Used With Healy Model 700, 800, and 900 Vapor Recovery Systems*, dated January 7, 2011. A Stage II recovery system or component must be independently evaluated by a third-party to be certified for use in Texas as required by Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §115.243(2). Ken Wilcox Associates Incorporated conducted the third-party evaluation.

The Greene World Nozzle was tested for approval when used with a Healy 700, 800, and 900 on-board refueling vapor recovery (ORVR) vac-assist systems. In accordance with 30 TAC §115.243(2), the Greene World Nozzle and components, as applicable to existing or new installations, is hereby certified for use with Healy 700, 800, and 900 ORVR vac-assist systems in Texas when installed and operated in accordance with manufacturer recommendations.
