DECISION OF THE COMMISSION REGARDING THE PETITION FOR RULEMAKING FILED BY THE CITY OF GRANITE SHOALS AND THE CITY OF LEANDER

Docket No. 2009-1586-RUL

On November 18, 2009, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission) considered the petition for rulemaking filed by Lloyd Gosselink Rochelle & Townsend, P.C. on behalf of the City of Granite Shoals and the City of Leander (petitioners). The petition, filed on September 25, 2009, requests that the agency initiate rulemaking to repeal 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 311, Subchapters A, B, and F, and the subsequent allowance to discharge reclaimed waters into the Highland Lakes watersheds.


IT IS THE DECISION OF THE COMMISSION pursuant to Administrative Procedure Act (APA), Texas Government Code, § 2001.021 and Texas Water Code, § 5.102 to deny the petition.

Agency adoption and revisions to 30 TAC Chapter 307 regarding Texas Surface Water Quality Standards, and related changes to implementation plans, are needed before further consideration of this issue, to ensure consistency with the statewide approach to nutrient criteria development and implementation.

This Decision constitutes the decision of the Commission required by the APA, § 2001.021(c).
