
On September 29, 2010, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission) considered the petition for rulemaking filed by the law firm of Grissom & Thompson L.L.P. The petition, filed on August 4, 2010, requests that the agency initiate rulemaking to increase certain reimbursable costs at eligible Leaking Petroleum Storage Tank (LPST) sites.

IT IS THE DECISION OF THE COMMISSION pursuant to Administrative Procedure Act (APA), Texas Government Code, § 2001.021 and Texas Water Code, § 5.102 to instruct the Executive Director to examine the issues in the petition and to initiate rulemaking.

This Decision constitutes the decision of the Commission required by the APA, § 2001.021(c).
