
Dear Mr. Hyde:

On behalf of my client, the Lakeway Municipal Utility District ("Lakeway MUD"), we hereby seek to withdraw—without prejudice—Lakeway MUD's petition for rulemaking to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (the "Commission"), filed on October 17, 2014 (seeking administrative rules to recognize the extended use of reclaimed water for beneficial use in lieu of excess storage and irrigable acreage requirements).

Notwithstanding this withdrawal, we look forward to working with you and your staff to further promote beneficial reuse and the value of reclaimed water – particularly in times of drought. We expect the dialogue to consider ways to recognize the successes of beneficial reuse strategies so as to improve flexibility for POTWs subject to 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 311, Subchapters A and B.
