1. Purpose. This change transmittal provides the pages that reflect changes and additions to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (commission) Volume of Permanent Rules.
2. Explanation of Change. On May 11, 2016, the commission adopted the following:
 - new §305.132 *with change* to the proposed text as published in the February 5, 2016, issue of the *Texas Register* (40 TexReg 930) and, therefore, the text was republished;
 - an amendment to §327.1 *without change* to the proposed text as published in the February 5, 2016, issue of the *Texas Register* (41 TexReg 933) and, therefore, the text was not republished; and
 - new §327.32 *with change* to the proposed text as published in the February 5, 2016, issue of the *Texas Register* (41 TexReg 933) and, therefore, the text was republished.
3. Effects of Change. The adopted rulemaking implements Senate Bill 912, 84th Texas Legislature, 2015, Regular Session, by including a new monthly-based reporting option for certain accidental discharges or spills of treated or untreated wastewater from wastewater treatment facilities and collection systems in the new and amended sections.
