### LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION LICENSE AFFIDAVIT

I, \_\_\_\_\_, hereby acknowledge that upon reactivation of my landscape Irrigator License, I, in accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 30, Subchapter D, § 30.120(f), may no longer engage in any irrigation inspections that rely upon or require a valid Irrigation Inspector License. I understand that I have chosen to become ineligible to hold a valid Irrigator Inspector License.

These restrictions apply to, but are not limited to, the following licenses issued by TCEQ:

1. Landscape Irrigator License; or
2. Landscape Irrigation Technician License.

I understand that should I decide to reacquire my Irrigator Inspector License prior to its expiration date, I will be required to reapply for the license and pass the applicable exam. If, however, I choose to reacquire my Irrigator Inspection License after it has been renewed, I will not be required to retake the exam. It is also understood that I am required to meet my continuing education requirements if I expect to reactivate my Irrigation Inspector license and I will be required to submit a new Irrigation License Affidavit.
