An applicant shall have verified military service, training, or education credited toward the licensing requirements under the following conditions:

- Verified military service, training, or education shall not be credited toward an examination requirement.
- This credit may not apply to an applicant who:
 - holds a restricted license issued by another jurisdiction; or
 - has an unacceptable criminal history.

Military Spouse

A license shall be issued to an applicant who is the spouse of a person serving on active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States and:

- holds a current license issued by another state that has licensing requirements that are substantially equivalent to the Texas requirements for the license; or
- within the five years preceding the application date held a Texas license that expired while the applicant lived in another state for at least six months.
