Irrigation Inspector License Affidavit (Applicants for a new license, reactivation or renewal)

I, _____, hereby acknowledge that upon issuance or reactivation of my Irrigation Inspector License, as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 30, Subchapter D, Section 30.120(e), I will not engage in or have a financial or advisory interest in any entity that:

1. Sells, designs, installs, maintains, alters, repairs, or services an irrigation system;
2. Provides consulting services relating to an irrigation system; or
3. Connects an irrigation system to any water supply.

I also understand that upon issuance or reactivation of my Irrigation Inspector license, I must relinquish ownership of any interest that I may have in any landscape irrigation company.

These restrictions apply to, but are not limited to, the following licenses issued by TCEQ:

1. Landscape Irrigator License; or
2. Landscape Irrigation Technician License.

I understand that should I decide to use my Landscape Irrigator License or Landscape Irrigation Technician License, while holding a valid Irrigation Inspector License, I must immediately cease to engage in any irrigation inspections that rely upon or require a valid Irrigation Inspector license.

To be eligible to reactivate my Landscape Irrigator or Technician License, I shall notify the TCEQ by completing the Landscape Irrigator/Technician License Affidavit.
