Dear Mr. Conner:

The revised effective federal operating permit (FOP) for Oiltanking Beaumont Partners, LP, Oiltanking Beaumont Terminal is enclosed. On September 3, 2010, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) notified the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) of objections to the issuance of the FOP. The TCEQ responded to EPA objections on November 30, 2010. Per the March 18, 2011 EPA letter to TCEQ, the objections to Oiltanking Beaumont Terminal's FOP have been addressed. This letter constitutes authority to operate the changes identified in the FOP revision application.

Consistent with Title 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 122, Subchapter C, the permit holder shall submit an application to the Air Permits Division (APD) for a revision to an FOP for those activities at a site which change, add, or remove one or more FOP terms or conditions. The permit holder shall also submit an application to the APD for a revision to a permit to address the following: the adoption of an applicable requirement previously designated as federally enforceable only; the promulgation of a new applicable requirement; the adoption of a new state-only requirement; or a change in a state-only designation.

Please note, changes have been made to the permit since commencement of the public announcement period. A detailed explanation of these changes is enclosed.

Modifications Made from the Draft to the Final Permit

- Stationary Vents subject to §111.111(a)(1)(A) were added to the Applicable Requirements Summary attachment. Special Term and Condition for vents subject to §111.111(a)(1)(A) was removed from the draft permit.
- Special Term and Condition 3. A. was updated.
- Term and Condition 16 regarding certification of compliance in accordance with 30 TAC §122.146 was added to the draft permit.
- The basis for determination section of the permit shield was updated. The emission groups GRPFUG2, GRPVFR1, and GRPVFR2 are not storing or transferring “organic liquids” as defined in 40 CFR Part 63, §63.2406(b)(1) and emission group GRPMRNL2 is a marine loading operation.
- Requirements for the emission group GRPFUG1 for 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart R were added to the Applicable Requirements Summary.
- The issuance date of site’s case-by-case permit was added to the NSR Authorization References.
- Removed from the permit the following units because these units have been demolished: T503, T504, T505, T507, T508, T509, T511, T513, T516, T517, T518, T519, T545, T548, T563, T567, T569, T570, T572, T573, T574, T577, and T578
- The unit BVESSEL was added to the permit with applicability to 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart BB and 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart Y in the group GRPMRNL1 with the NSR authorizations 106.261/11/01/2003 and 106.262/11/01/2003 issued on 07/05/2011.
- The unit DK FUG B was added to the permit with applicability to 40 CFR Part 61, Subparts J, and V and 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart R in the group GRPFUG1 with the NSR authorizations 106.261/11/01/2003 and 106.262/11/01/2003 issued on 07/05/2011.
- The units LD 3-1 and LD 15-1 were added to the permit with applicability to 30 TAC Chapter 115, Subchapter B, Storage of VOCs, 40 CFR Part 60, Subpart Kb and 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart R in the group GRPVFR2 with the NSR authorizations 106.478/09/04/2000 issued on 11/08/2011 and 106.472/09/04/2000 issued on 03/28/2013, respectively.
- The units 100-32, 160-7, and 160-8 were added to the permit with applicability to 30 TAC Chapter 115, Subchapter B, Storage of VOCs, 40 CFR Part 60, Subpart Kb and 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart R in the group GRPIFR3 with the NSR authorizations 106.478/09/04/2000 issued on 04/04/2011, 106.478/09/04/2000 issued on 08/29/2011, and 106.478/09/04/2000 issued on 08/29/2011, respectively.
