



**Exemption § 106.418 Checklist  
(Previously Standard Exemption 13)  
Non-Heatset Printing Equipment**

The following checklist has been developed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to provide verification that the basic requirements of Exemption § 106.418, previously Standard Exemption 13, are met. The following questions are derived from the specific conditions of the exemption. Please read all of the questions and provide specific information applicable to the facility. If all applicable conditions of the specific exemption are not met, the facility will not be allowed to operate under exemption and an application for a construction permit will be required pursuant to §116.110 prior to construction. The TCEQ Non-Heatset Printing Technical Guidance Package provides calculation information and examples.

What type of printing equipment involved? <i>[Note: Xerographic copying and duplicating equipment does not require exemption.]</i>	
What are the emissions of volatile organic compounds (VOC) and exempt solvents (Non-VOC) from any single press or operation (tpy). <i>[Note: If these emissions are greater than 15 tpy, exemption cannot be used.]</i>	
What are the emissions of VOC and Non-VOC from all printing equipment and operations on the plant site? (tpy) <i>[Note: If these emissions are greater than 25 tpy, exemption cannot be used. If these emissions are 10 tpy or more, submit a Form PI-7 to TCEQ.]</i>	
Is heated air is used to shorten drying time? <span style="float: right;"><input type="checkbox"/> YES   <input type="checkbox"/> NO</span> If "YES", what is the temperature of the heated air? (°F) <i>[Note: If greater than 194°F, exemption cannot be used except for screen printing for which temperature restriction does not apply.]</i>
