Thank you for the extension. We have reviewed the draft permit and have just a few comments:

1. In the Applicable Requirements Summary Table for PTED-EFP1, Index 60III-1, the row for NMHC+NOX pollutant is missing the textual description. Will you please add the appropriate text.
2. Regarding the 60MMA citations for PRO-PSURF, we agree with the additional citations Table 1.1.a.i, 1.1.a.ii, and 1.1.a.iii for the thermal oxidizer. GM also uses a concentrator. Therefore, we would like to add citations § 60.392a(g) – Table 1.5.a.i-iii as well.

Please provide an updated draft once these changes are made.

We agree with using the “NO” code for the AECD question on UA2 for STMPGEN.

We have the following comments on the draft permit:

1. It looks like Special Term and Condition 11 is a duplicate of term 10. Please remove term 11.
2. In the Applicable Requirements Summary Table for PRO-PSURF, Index 60MMa-1, there are a few citations that are missing and a few “[G]” grouping notations that are missing from the OP-REQ3 that was provided. We have marked up the attached draft permit with the preferred applicable citations.
3. In the Applicable Requirements Summary Table for PTED-EFP1, Index 60III-1, we noticed that the row for NMHC+NOX pollutant is missing and it should be added back to the permit.
4. In the permit shield table, we noticed that you added the permit shields for new units GMFE and GMPC. Since this is a minor revision, please remove these permit shields from the permit. We will request to add them in the future renewal.
5. In the New Source Review Authorization References table, please make the following changes to match the PBR SUP and the OP-REQ1 previously submitted:
 - a. Add SE 8, Version Date 04/05/1995
 - b. Add SE 103, Version Date 06/07/1996
 - c. Remove PBR 106.262, Version Date 09/04/2000
 - d. Add PBR 106.317, Version Date 09/04/2000

I wanted to reach out and send you an updated Working Draft Permit for your review. Requirements for emission unit STMPGEN, index number 60III-1, have changed and now do not list the following citations: § 60.4218, § 89.112(a). These two citations are no longer part of the requirements for pollutant CO, NMHC and NOX, and PM.

This change is due an incident in our database which affected unit STMPGEN. Therefore, I conducted a data interpretation of code “No” for AECD on form OP-UA2 Table 5c. Please confirm if this data interpretation is correct. If it is not correct, please provide form OP-UA2 with updated unit attributes.

Please get back to me with your review and confirmation by **August 8, 2025.**

- On the UA62 for unit GMDEHY and MACT HH, on Table 1a you indicate "Area" for the attribute "HAP Source". Then, for the attribute "Affected Source Type" you indicated "SMALL." However, per the instructions, "SMALL" is an option for a Major Source. The options for an Area Source are TEGU or NTEGU. Please provide an updated UA62 with proper responses. Note that based on the responses to "HAP Source", "Affected Source Type", and "Area Source Exemption", additional responses and Tables may be necessary. Please provide as pertinent.
- On the UA3 for unit GMGST and Chapter 115, Storage of VOCs, on Table 4a for the attribute "Storage Capacity", "A1K" is provided as the response. Please note that "A1K" is not an available option. Please submit an updated UA3 using the current form version (4/25), identifying a correct Code for "Storage Capacity" for facilities in Tarrant County.

Please provide these updates at your earliest opportunity, but please no later than COB on 7/8/2025.

Regarding the 60MMa CAM for PRO-PSURF, since the new subpart MMa was first proposed by EPA on May 18, 2022 in [87 FR 30141](#), we believe CAM is exempt from this rule. This would fall into the category of CAM exemptions for standards proposed by the EPA after November 15, 1990.

Therefore, we now believe CAM is no longer required for PRO-PSURF and 60MMa. If TCEQ agrees, then we no longer require CAM to be added back to the permit for this unit.

Thank you again for the additional information and guidance. GM will submit updated form OP-REQ3, and page 88 of form OP-REQ1 to reflect the updated issuance dates for the NSR Authorizations at the site.

As a follow-up to our discussion on OP-PBRSUP form, I reviewed the renewal application of Title V permit issued on 9/14/2022 and noticed that Form OP-PBRSUP was submitted to TCEQ on 5/2/2022. This Title V permit expires

on 9/14/2027, which means GM will have to submit a renewal application between 3/14/2026 and 3/14/2027. The renewal application window will start in less than a year.

I also reviewed the table “Forms for Various Federal Operating Permit (FOP) Project Types” on TCEQ website. I have pasted a snippet from that table below, which indicates that OP-PBR SUP is “potentially” required and be submitted “only if needed”.

General Motors LLC (GM) hereby applies for a minor revision of existing Title V Federal Operating Permit (FOP) O1151 for the Arlington Assembly Plant located in Arlington, TX.

As indicated in a separate letter being submitted, per 40 CFR Part 60, Subpart MMa 60.395a (a)(3) to TCEQ and USEPA Region VI, the vehicle paint shop at the plant is planning to make certain physical changes to prime coating operation to increase hourly vehicle painting capacity from 60.5 jobs per hour (JPH) to 62.5 JPH. Existing prime booth coating operation is subject to 40 CFR 60 Subpart MM. The physical changes to the operation meets the definition of "modification" per 40 CFR 60.14(a), and therefore modified prime coating operation will be subject to the requirements of 40 CFR 60, Subpart MMa.

GM understands that the facility will be able to start the modified primer operation after Title V minor revision application is submitted in STEERS ePermits. GM intends to start operating the modified prime coating operation on or after 02/10/2025.
