

On behalf of Crown Cork & Seal USA ("CCS") Ramboll Americas Engineering Solutions, Inc. ("Ramboll") is submitting this Air Permits Division (APD) Notification form under 30 TAC 106.264: Replacement of Facilities for the facility located in Sugar Land, Fort Bend County, Texas.

CCS is proposing to replace one of the existing coating operations with a decorator in their facility which is authorized under NSR Permit 9331. Currently Line 3 has one (1) decorator and one (1) coater that are used depending on the type of the finish product required. If white coated cans are required, then coater is used and if printed cans are required then decorator is used. Due to a change in the market, there is no longer any demand for white coated cans. Thus, the proposed project will replace the white coater with a decorator.

Function of the decorator is to apply Inks and printing blanket on the rotary printer and transfer it on the cans as they rotate on mandrel. The function of the new decorator is same as the old coater except that the decorator can print multiple designs vs the coater can only apply primer or topcoat. The new decorator will allow CCS to switch from one label (e.g. Pepsi design) to another (e.g. Coke) more seamlessly as one decorator can be loaded with one design and second one can be loaded with second design. Line 3 will be only able to produce non-white coated cans.

Printed cans are transferred from the decorator to the curing oven where they are cured. Emissions from the can manufacturing - printing process and curing process are routed and controlled by a thermal oxidizer as mentioned in Special Conditions of issued Permit 9331 section 9(C). Thermal Oxidizer is authorized as EPN I-1 (Source name: Can Manufacturing - Thermal Oxidizer) under Permit 9331.

After the proposed modification, the line restrictions and interlock prevent simultaneous operation of the decorators preventing any actual increase in the production. Since the process is a linear process, the maximum production rate is dependent on the other restrictions in the line, in this case the capacity of the inside spray operations, which has not changed. There we do not anticipate any change in production rate or emissions. There is no change in the curing oven which is point of emission release or the thermal oxidizer which is a control device. The replacement of the decorator will not lead to any change in the production rate, efficiency, or throughput as the rates are depended on the previous line which does not have any change. There are no emission increases or decreases associated with the replacement.

CCS intends to authorize the replacement under 30 TAC 106.264 and will later incorporate the authorization in the NSR permit 9331 during the next renewal.

A line-by-line review of the 30 TAC 106.264: Replacement of Facilities is in Attachment A as part of this application package that demonstrates compliance for these process changes. The required APD Relocation/Notification Form, TCEQ Form – 20122, Core Data Form, TCEQ Form – 10400, and supporting documents associated with the application is provided in Attachment B, C, and D.

30 TAC 106.264 REVIEW

30 TAC 106.264: REPLACEMENT OF FACILITIES REVIEW

A facility which replaces an existing facility is permitted by rule provided that the following conditions of this section are satisfied:

- 1) the replacement facility functions in the same or similar manner as the facility to be replaced;
Replaced decorator functions similar to the existing coaters.
- 2) the emissions from the replacement facility are not more than nor have different characteristics than those from the facility to be replaced; *CCS does not anticipate emissions changes from the replaced decorator.*
- 3) the emissions from the replacement facility will not exceed 25 tons per year of any air contaminant; *CCS does not anticipate emissions changes from the replaced decorator, decorator will have insignificant emissions.*
- 4) the physical location of the replacement facility is the same or immediately adjacent to the facility being replaced; *There will be no change in location. See attachment D for reference.*
- 5) there will be no increase in capacity, production rate, or throughput as a result of the replacement; *There will be no change in capacity, production rate, or throughput.*
- 6) notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (3) of this section, the emissions from the replacement facility will not contain any compounds (other than carbon monoxide, nitrogen oxide, or sulfur dioxide) listed or proposed to be listed as hazardous constituents in 40 Code of Federal Regulations 261, Appendix VIII; *Decorator emissions, if any, will not contain any compounds listed above.*
- 7) notification of the replacement is provided to the executive director within ten days following installation of the replacement facility. *Notification is submitted after installation.*




