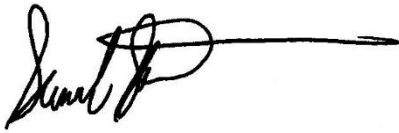

1. Introduction

SJRR Power LLC (SJRR) owns and operates the SJRR Power Peaking Facility located in Houston, Harrison County, Texas. The SJRR Power Peaking Facility is currently authorized under New Source Review (NSR) Permit No. 155895 and Title V Operating Permit No. O4153.

The SJRR Power Peaking Facility consists of two natural gas-fired combustion turbines (CTs), identified as CT1 and CT2. SJRR is submitting this Title V Site Operating Permit (SOP) revision application to include an additional option for monitoring carbon monoxide (CO) from the combustion turbines using continuous emissions monitoring systems (CEMS). In addition, SJRR would like to revise the existing periodic monitoring provisions for the CTs.

The current Title V permit indicates the stationary turbines are subject to 30 TAC Chapter 117, Subchapter B. SJRR is revising the applicability to 30 TAC Chapter 117, Subchapter C. With the proposed update to 30 TAC Chapter 117, Subchapter C, the stationary turbines will be subject to 117.1210.

The stationary turbines are subject to 30 TAC Chapter 117.310(c)(1) that limits CO emissions from exceeding 400 ppmv at 3.0% O₂, dry basis. The current permit requires CO monitoring according to 117.310(c)(1)(B), on a one-hour average for units not equipped with CEMS or PEMS. SJRR is proposing to include 117.1210(b)(1)(B) as a monitoring option and also update the current monitoring option of 117.310(c)(1)(B) to the equivalent Subchapter C requirement of 117.1210(b)(1)(A). Additionally, SJRR is proposing to revise the existing Periodic Monitoring provisions for CO to indicate that the CO deviation limit of 400 ppmv at 3.0% of O₂, dry, applies only during normal operations and not during startup and shutdown operations. The CTs are peaking units and may initiate up to four startup/shutdown sequences within a 24-hour period.

SJRR would also like to use this revision to update the applicable requirements for the CTs for New Source Performance Standard Subpart KKKK. The units are currently represented in the permit as modified or reconstructed turbines. However, the CTs were new units, constructed after 2005. The forms to correct this representation are included in this submittal.

The following documentation is provided with this revision application: all required Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) SOP application forms, including forms addressing application certification, administrative information, and unit attribute information.

2. Process Description

The SJRR Power Peaking Facility consists of two 50 MW gas-fired simple-cycle turbine peaking units and associated ancillary equipment. NO_x emissions from the turbines are controlled by Selective Catalytic Reduction (SCR) devices.

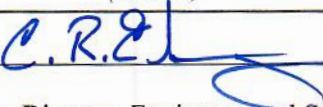
