This letter notifies you that the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has received a federal operating permit (FOP) initial issuance application for a site located in your district. As part of this permitting process, the applicant is required to publish a formal newspaper public notice. The notice will inform the public of their right to make comments or request a public hearing. The FOP program regulates both new and existing major sources of emissions. The goal of the program is to improve air quality in Texas through increased compliance by codifying existing applicable regulatory requirements into the FOP. The FOP provides the applicant authorization to operate the equipment at the site. The FOP identifies and codifies air emission requirements (known as applicable requirements) that apply to the emission units at the site. The FOP does not authorize construction of emission units or emissions from those units. The New Source Review (NSR) permit is the mechanism for these authorizations.

1.0 Introduction

IE US Development Holdings 3 Inc. proposes to operate the Childress Data Center located at 620 FM 1033, Childress, Texas, 79201. The site is a data center designed to house server equipment within multiple data hall buildings supported by central utility infrastructure.

The Childress Data Center's primary operations consist of digital data processing and high-density computing activities. Under normal operating conditions, the site receives primary electrical power directly from the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) transmission grid via an on-site substation. Incoming utility power is routed to the data hall buildings (server operations) and the central utility plant (CUP). The CUP supports cooling and other auxiliary infrastructure necessary for continuous data center operations.

The Childress Data Center's emission sources include emergency generators and storage tanks. All emergency generators are stationary, diesel-fired, reciprocating internal combustion engines that will operate only in the event of utility power interruption. Each emergency engine will operate no more than 50 hours per year (hr/yr) for maintenance, testing, or other non-emergency purposes. The site will include 320 emergency generators, each supplied by a dedicated aboveground diesel storage tank, for a total of 320 diesel storage tanks across all phases. Diesel fuel is delivered to the site by tank truck and transferred into the storage tanks. The site does not generate electricity for commercial sale or export to the grid. As specified in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 106 (30 TAC §106), the Childress Data Center is authorized under Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Permit by Rule (PBR) documentation under §§106.4, 106.472, and 106.511.

Per the requirements of §122.130(b)(1) under 30 TAC Chapter 122, IE US Development Holdings 3 Inc. submits this abbreviated initial Federal Operating Permit (FOP) application prior to operating the new emission units at the site. Completed OP-1, OP-CRO-1, and Core Data forms are provided with this abbreviated initial application. IE US Development Holdings 3 Inc. understands that TCEQ will inform company officials in writing of the deadline for submitting additional application information as specified in §122.130(b)(1).
