

Certificate Search in Integrated Web Reporting (IWR)

Step 1: From the [PST Registration Database](#), click on "IWR(Integrated web reporting)."

The certificate text states: "This hereby certifies that the underground storage tanks (USTs) at the facility identified herein have been self-certified as compliant with all technical and administrative standards for fuel delivery purposes. This certificate verifies self certification only, and does not certify that the listed USTs are in compliance with TCEQ's Technical and Administrative requirements. *Prior to retail sale of fuel to the public using measured dispensing devices, any meter must be registered with the Texas Department of Agriculture.*"

At the bottom, it notes: "For the specific time period and the *Underground Storage Tanks (USTs)* indicated, this certificate verifies self-certification by the tank owner or operator of compliance with TCEQ rule requirements listed at 30 TAC Sec. 334.8(c)(3)(D). [Regarding tank registration, payment of registration fees, UST financial responsibility (e.g.]"
