

Drinking Water Technical Review Team

Drought

- **1,139** public water systems (PWSs) asking customers to follow outdoor water use restrictions.
 - Of these systems, **752** are asking customers to follow a mandatory watering schedule and
 - **387** are asking customers to follow a voluntary watering schedule.
- Seasonal forecasts continue to predict the drought to persist or intensify in some areas of the state. Decreasing demands are resulting in more water systems relaxing the water-rationing stages of their Drought Contingency Plans.
- Currently **50** PWSs have prohibited all outside watering.

Ground Water Rule (GWR)

- **97** Systems received TSM Violation
- **8** Systems received ASM Violation
- **10** Systems received Corrective Action
- **8** Purchasing Systems received violations for not informing Wholesale providers of a positive in the distribution system
- **11** GWR Corrective Action Letters Mailed
- **5** Triggered Source Monitoring Plans were completed (2 Approvals, 3 Denials)
- **942** Raw Water Samples Posted
- **424** GWR & TCR phone calls / **17** Meetings and Trainings Attended

Emergency Preparedness Plan (EPP)

- **8** EPP Projects Submitted
- **5** EPP Letters Mailed

Ground Water Source Inventory / Ground Water Under The Influence (GUI)

- Processed **38** newly-approved groundwater well completion packages
- Reviewed **215** Comprehensive Compliance Investigation reports; updated SDWIS to reflect all changes related to well owner ID / physical address / activity status / tested capacity (gpm)
- Reviewed locational data (lat/long) for **4,017** PWS supply sources in ArcGIS; improved accuracy of locations for 49.3% of sources
- Created MS Access database to archive historical MPA data (**503** laboratory sample results) used in pre-2005 GUI determinations

Exceptions & Public Information Requests (PIRs)

- Regular Exception Review Requests Completed: **34**; Expedited: **0**
- Reviewed and responded to **302** PIRs

Source Water Assessment & Protection (SWAP) / Source Water Protection (SWP)

- Hope to have a SWP contractor in place soon.
- Currently compiling a list of water systems for participation in the SWP program during FY14.
- Plan to complete SWP plans for **12** water systems by August 31, 2014.
- Continue to provide SWP technical assistance to: Texas Rural Water Association, EPA and others.

Data Support

- Continued work on testing and documenting E2 and associated bugs
- SDWIS 3.2 upgrade in progress
- Developed online Data request form
- Data Support (IDA) requests completed: **118**
- Trained existing staff on WUD
- Data entry: DLQOR – **4412**; CLO2 – **211**; Chlorite – **270**
- Re-structured SVN repository
- **1257** Surface Water Monthly Operating reports entered
- Return to Compliance (RTC): **2884** violations returned to compliance and migrated into SDWIS
- Development of Data Sheet in Drinking Water Watch (DWW) to re-direct user from iWUD for PDW information – in progress
- Federal Reporting of Compliance Data to EPA
 - Texas submitted over **1.4** million (**1,419,201**) records to EPA for review
 - These data include information on public water system facilities, comp samples, and violations/enforcements
 - TCEQ achieved a total error rate of 0.2% for FY13
