## EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN WORKSHOP

On October 23, 2018, **America's Water Infrastructure Act (AWIA)** was signed into law. The law requires community (drinking) water systems serving more than 3,300 people to develop or update risk assessments and emergency response plans (ERPs).

Deadlines based on population served:

- **March 31, 2020** — 100,000 or more customers
- **December 31, 2020** — 50,000 - 100,000 customers
- **June 30, 2021** — 3,300 - 50,000 customers
