ABANDONMENT OF WATER RIGHT

Notice: This form will not be processed until all delinquent fees and/or penalties owed to the TCEQ or the Office of the Attorney General on behalf of the TCEQ are paid in accordance with the Delinquent Fee and Penalty Protocol.

Please note that this action to voluntarily abandon, and the subsequent cancellation of, your water right may not be reversed and obtaining a water right in the future will require a new application for water. New applications require application/notice fees and may or may not be granted, subject to water availability. Additionally, water rights in the State of Texas may add value to the property they are associated with and/or may have a monetary value of their own. Please consider all of this in determining whether you wish to proceed with abandoning your water right.

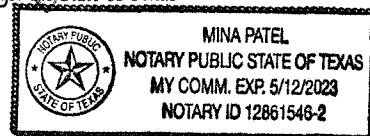

Dear Ms. Ellis

Thank you for your note on the recent invoice that was mailed to water right holders in the jurisdiction of the Brazos Watermaster Program. The invoice you received was for Certificate of Adjudication Number 12-3011, which authorizes the diversion and use of 46.99 acre-feet of water per year from the Lampasas River to irrigate out of a 52.45 acre tract in Bell County. The current owner of record is Lawana Ellis Et Vir.

You've indicated that you would like to avoid future assessments. There are several options available to you as it pertains to your water right. You have the ability to sell your water right to another entity or individual; abandon your water right; or retain your water right. You expressed an interest in abandoning your water right. If you still wish to proceed, you will find the necessary form attached. If you wish to retain your water right, simply disregard the form. Please be aware that for a request to abandon a water right to be processed by the TCEQ's Water Right Permit program, all outstanding balances must have been paid.
