- Target Processing Time: 90 days

House Bill 1964 Applications

- HB1964, passed during the 86th legislative session, provided an expedited process for certain water rights applications.
- Target Processing Time: 90 days
- FY21 Q4
 - Received: 11
 - Completed: 11
 - 100% Processed within 90 Days

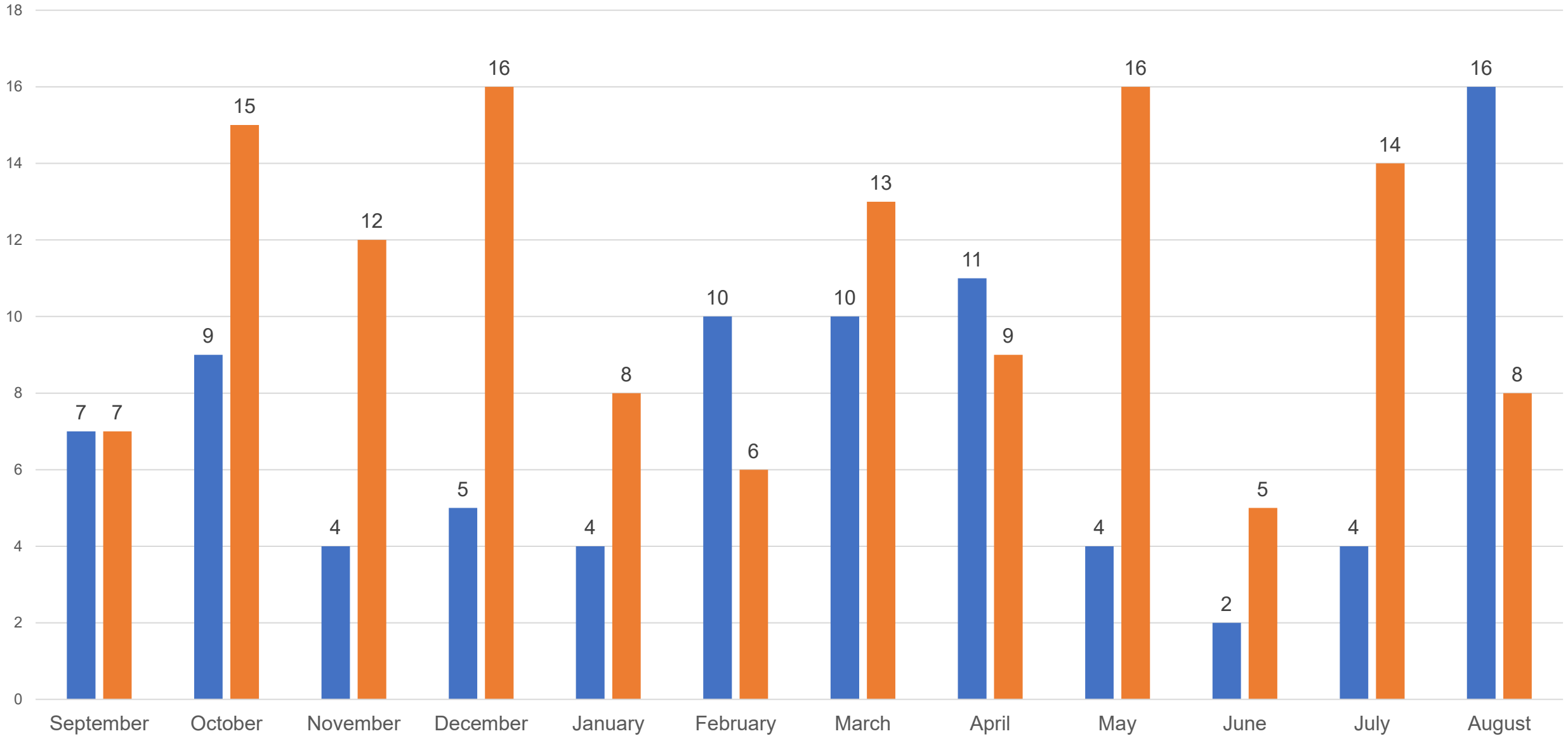
Fast Track Applications

- Fast Tracks are applications that don't require substantial modeling.
- Target Processing Time: 300 days
- FY21 Q4
 - Received: 34
 - Completed: 74
 - 64% Processed within 300 Days

Permitting Updates

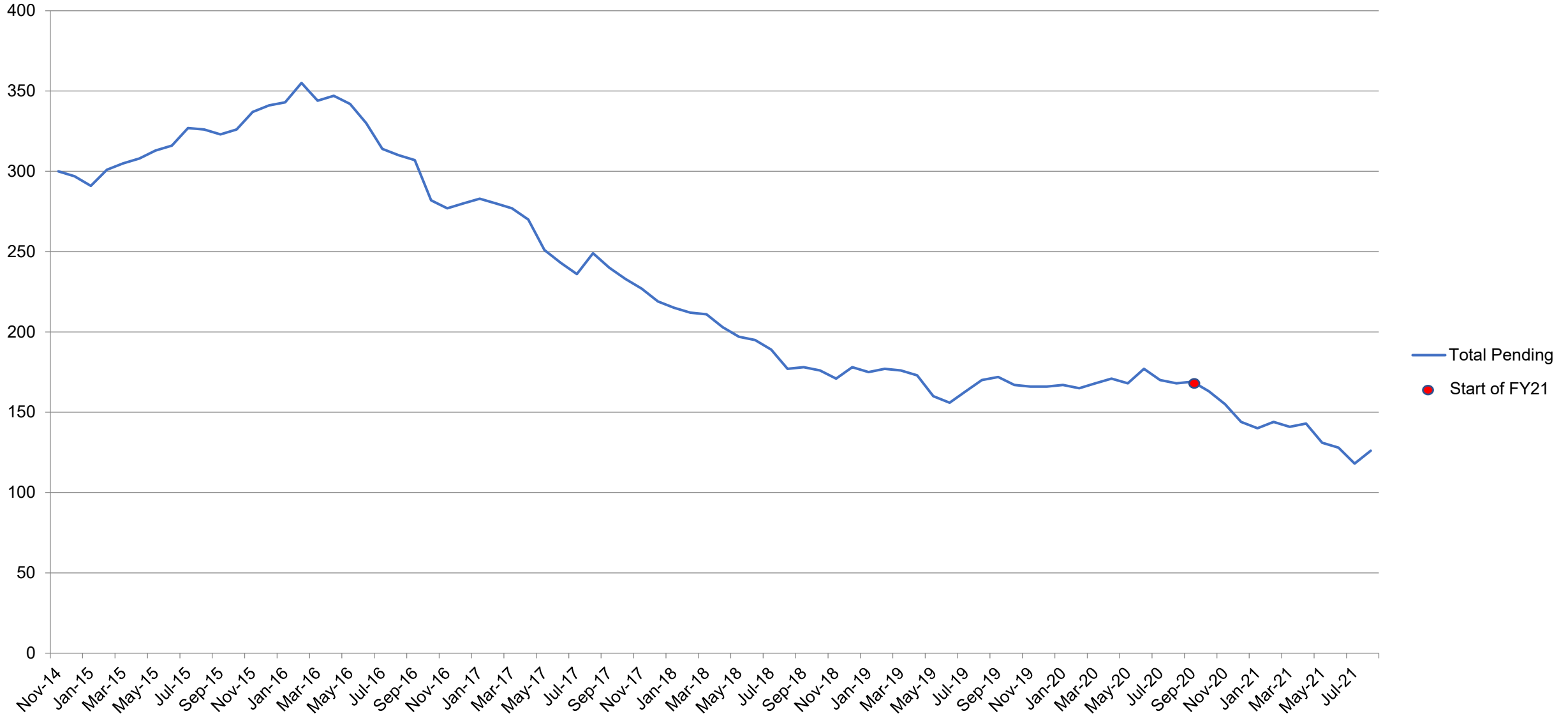
- Pending September 13, 2021: 126
 - 19 of those have hearing requests
- FY21 Q4
 - Received: 86
 - Completed: 129
 - Issued: 100
 - Withdrawn: 11
 - Returned: 18
- Pre-application meetings will be required starting Jan. 1, 2022

Water Rights Received vs. Processed for FY2021

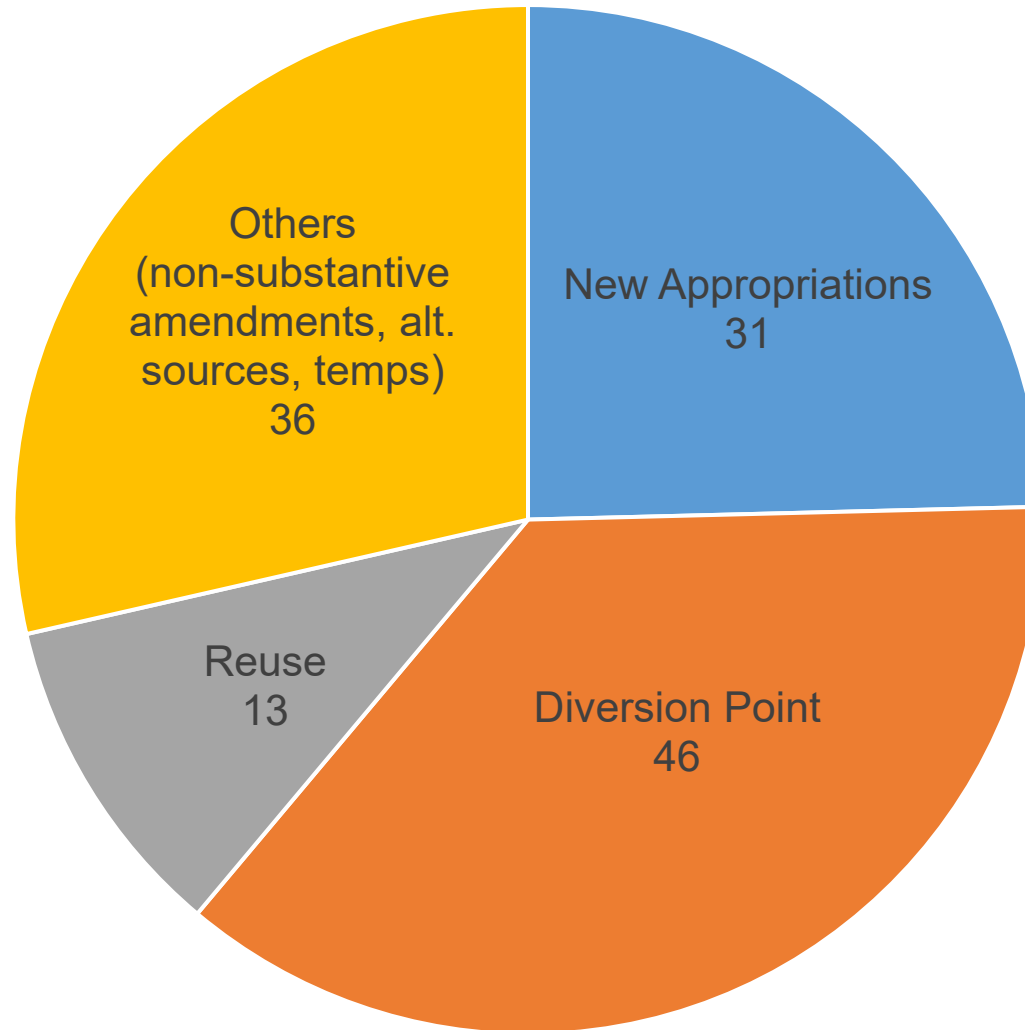


Water Rights Permitting
