

Hall Street Site On-Site Work Notification

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) is conducting an on-going investigation of the Hall Street State Superfund Site (the Site), located at the intersection of California Street and 20th Street East, Dickinson, Galveston County, Texas. During the 1960s, the Site was used for unpermitted waste disposal.

During the next several months, the TCEQ will be performing work at the Site, which will include mowing the Site to control vegetation and installing several on-site groundwater monitoring wells. The TCEQ will collect samples from the groundwater monitoring wells and analyze the data to identify the most appropriate action necessary to address the contamination on the Site to protect human health and the environment.

The TCEQ will also be extending the temporary roads on-site for the use of heavy equipment needed to install the additional groundwater monitoring wells.
