Public Hearing Notice

The Texas Water Commission is required under the Texas Solid Waste Disposal Act, Texas Civil Statutes, Article 4477-7, (the Act) §13, to identify and assess hazardous waste facilities or areas which may constitute an imminent and substantial endangerment to public health and safety or to the environment. The first registry identifying those sites was published in the *Texas Register* on January 16, 1987, (12 TexReg 205). Pursuant to the Act, §13(c), the commission must update the registry annually to add new facilities, or to delete those facilities that have been cleaned up pursuant to the Act, §13(g) or delisted pursuant to §13(e). The registry was last updated on January 22, 1988, (13 TexReg 427).

International Creosoting, located at 110 Pine Street, Beaumont, is a site being proposed for inclusion on the registry. A hearing has been scheduled, at the following time and place, to receive information from any interested member of the public about the proposed site, including past or current waste management practices, potentially responsible parties, and possible remediation activities: December 15, 1988, at 6:30 p.m., Beaumont Civic Center, 701 Main Street, Beaumont.

Persons desiring to comment on the proposed inclusion of this site on the registry should do so in the context of this public hearing. Comments relating to this facility identified may be submitted orally or in writing at the hearing. Oral presentations should be accompanied by written comments. Written comments will be accepted until December 31, 1988.

Notice of Application For Waste Disposal Permit

Notice is given by the Texas Water Commission of public notices of waste disposal permit applications issued during the period of October 31-November 4, 1988.

No public hearing will be held on these applications unless an affected person has requested a public hearing. Any such request for a public hearing shall be in writing and contain the name, mailing address, and phone number of the person making the request; and a brief description of how the requester, or persons represented by the requester, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application. If the commission determines that the request sets out an issue which is relevant to the waste discharge permit decision, or that a public hearing would serve the public interest, the commission shall conduct a public hearing, after the issuance of proper and timely notice of the hearing. If no sufficient request for hearing is received within 30 days of the date of publication of notice concerning the applications, the permit will be submitted to the commission for final decision on the application.
