EPA to Begin Work to Plug and Abandon Water Wells

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recently received funding to plug and abandon the water wells of customers who were connected to the water line installed by EPA and TCEQ in 2008. Plugging and abandonment of the water wells is scheduled to begin in late October 2011 and will take approximately one month to complete. Once the White Oak Bend Municipal Utility District receives the well plugging report, there will no longer be a need for an annual inspection of the reduced pressure zone backflow prevention assembly for residential water service connections.

EPA is working with their contractor, EA Engineering, to plug and abandon these water wells before December 1, 2011. To schedule an appointment to discuss the plugging of your well, you may contact EA Engineering's Houston office at 713-896-4111.
