Re: Restrictions of Surface Water Rights

Dear Water Right Holder:

This letter is to inform you that should the current dry conditions continue to worsen, it may become necessary to begin restrictions and possibly curtail state surface water diversions throughout the Concho River Basin. The lack of significant rainfall and the declining flow of the Concho River and its tributaries may make this action necessary.

**Should the restrictions begin or expand, the priority dates of the water rights will determine the amount and frequency of the diversions. We ask that you call our office at the following toll free number (1-866-314-4894) or 325-481-8069 should you have any further questions on this matter.**

**This will also serve notice that the "Temporary Water Rights" in the area must be suspended should any appropriated water rights be restricted.**

We thank you for your cooperation. We ask that everyone join in and do their part to conserve water whenever possible.
