

In addition to requesting suspension of the rules identified in the attached Rules Suspension Request, the Executive Director of the TCEQ requests the following:

**Request for Suspension of TCEQ Rules**

**Date: September 19, 2019**

Consistent with the Governor's Proclamation of September 19, 2019, the Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality requests written approval for the suspension of the following rules because they prevent, hinder or delay necessary action in coping with the severe weather and flooding event that began on September 17, 2019. Such suspension is requested only to the extent the rules actually do prevent, hinder or delay necessary action in coping with this disaster. Any suspension is limited to the duration of the disaster declaration and is restricted to those counties set forth in the Proclamation referenced above, including any amendments. Regulated entities must prepare and maintain records related to the actions and suspended rules. It should be noted that some of these rules may have federal counterparts in statute or regulation and this suspension would not apply to such federal counterparts.
