What the adopted action would do:

This action will approve the rules review of Chapter 217, and readopt the chapter.

This action constitutes a determination by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, after opportunity for public review and comment, that the initial reasons for adopting the rules of this chapter continue to exist.

Applicable law:

The review of the rules is authorized under the requirements of Texas Government Code, § 2001.039; and the General Appropriations Act, Article IX, §9-10.13, 76th Texas Legislature, 1999, which require state agencies to review and consider for readoption each of their rules every four years.

Reason rules are needed:

Executive director's staff conducted a review of the rules in Chapter 217 and determined that the reasons for adopting these rules continue to exist. The rules provide design standards for treatment facilities, sewer systems, and disposal systems that transport, treat, or dispose of domestic wastewater. The rules also provide the standards that the commission uses in its review and approval of design plans and specifications. The rules are necessary to ensure that domestic wastewater systems are designed and operated to be protective of human health and the environment.

A public hearing was not offered for this review. The comment period for the rules review closed on January 3, 2024. No comments were received.

The Texas State Library and Archives Commission (commission) has completed its review of Texas Administrative Code, Title 13, Part 1,

Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Chapter 217 – Design Criteria for Domestic Wastewater Systems Non-Rule Project No. 2023-013-217-OW

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has completed its Rule Review of 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 217, Design Criteria for Domestic Wastewater Systems, as required by Texas Government Code (TGC), §2001.039. TGC, §2001.039, requires a state agency to review and consider for readoption, readoption with amendments, or repeal each of its rules every four years. TCEQ published its Notice of Intent to Review these rules in the November 24, 2023, issue of the *Texas Register* (48 TexReg 6922).

The review assessed whether the initial reasons for adopting the rules continue to exist and TCEQ has determined that those reasons exist. The rules in Chapter 217 are required because the rules provide design standards for treatment facilities, sewer systems, and disposal systems that transport, treat, or dispose of domestic wastewater. The rules also provide the standards that TCEQ uses in its review and approval of design plans and specifications. The rules are necessary to ensure that domestic wastewater systems are designed and operated to be protective of human health and the environment.

Public Comment

The public comment period closed on January 3, 2024. TCEQ did not receive comments on the rules review of this chapter.
