AGREED ORDER

DOCKET NO. 2020-0945-PWS-E

On ______, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("Commission" or "TCEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement action regarding GREEN ACRES RV PARK & RENTALS LLC ("Respondent") under the authority of Tex. Health & Safety Code ch. 341. The Executive Director of the TCEQ, represented by the Litigation Division, and Respondent presented this Order to the Commission.

Respondent understands that it has certain procedural rights at certain points in the enforcement process, including the right to formal notice of violations, to request an evidentiary hearing, receive notice of an evidentiary hearing, and a right to appeal. By entering into this Order, Respondent agrees to waive all notice and procedural rights which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action.

It is further understood and agreed that this Order represents the complete and fully-integrated agreement of the parties. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable. The duties and responsibilities imposed by this Order are binding upon Respondent.

The Commission makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent owned and operated a public water supply ("PWS") located at 1702 US Highway 90A West near Hallettsville, Lavaca County, Texas (the "Facility"). The Facility provided water for human consumption, had approximately 27 service connections, and served at least 25 people per day for at least 60 days per year. As such, the Facility was a PWS as defined in 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 290.38(71).
- 2. During a record review conducted on May 8, 2020, an investigator documented that Respondent failed to issue public notification and submit a copy of the public notification to the Executive Director regarding the failure to conduct routine coliform monitoring for the month of January 2016.
- 3. During a record review conducted on September 28, 2020, through October 16, 2020, an investigator documented that Respondent failed to collect, within 24 hours of notification of the routine distribution total coliform-positive samples on September 17, 2018, and October 11, 2018, at least one raw groundwater source *Escherichia coli* (or other approved fecal indicator) sample from the active groundwater source in use at the time the distribution coliform-positive samples were collected.
- 4. The Executive Director recognizes that Respondent no longer owns or operates the Facility as of November 24, 2021.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 1, Respondent is subject to the jurisdiction of the TCEQ pursuant to Tex. Health & Safety Code ch. 341 and the rules of the TCEQ.
- 2. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2, Respondent failed to issue public notification and submit a copy of the public notification to the Executive Director regarding the failure to conduct routine coliform monitoring for the month of January 2016, in violation of TCEQ Agreed Order Docket No. 2018-0050-PWS-E, Ordering Provision No. 2.a.ii.
- 3. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 3, Respondent failed to collect, within 24 hours of notification of the routine distribution total coliform-positive samples on September 17, 2018, and October 11, 2018, at least one raw groundwater source *Escherichia coli* (or other approved fecal indicator) sample from the active groundwater source in use at the time the distribution coliform-positive samples were collected, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.109(d)(4)(B).
- 4. Pursuant to Tex. Health & Safety Code § 341.049(a), TCEQ has the authority to assess an administrative penalty against Respondent for violations of state statutes within TCEQ's jurisdiction, for violations of rules adopted under such statutes, or for violations of orders or permits issued under such statutes.
- 5. An administrative penalty in the amount of \$758 is justified by the facts recited in this Order, and considered in light of the factors set forth in Tex. Health & Safety Code § 341.049(b). Respondent paid \$758 of the penalty.

ORDERING PROVISIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ORDERS that:

- 1. Respondent is assessed an administrative penalty as set forth in Conclusion of Law No. 5 for violations of state statutes and rules of the TCEQ. The payment of this penalty and Respondent's compliance with all requirements set forth in this Order resolve only the matters set forth by this Order in this action. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective actions or penalties for violations which are not raised here.
- 2. All relief not expressly granted in this Order is denied.
- 3. The duties and provisions imposed by this Order shall apply to and be binding upon Respondent.
- 4. This Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") to: (1) enforce the terms of this Order, or (2) pursue violations of a statute within TCEQ's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by TCEQ under such a statute. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the OAG for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that Respondent has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Order.
- 5. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable, and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.
- 6. This Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, whichever is later.
- 7. This Order may be executed in separate and multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single instrument. Any page of this Order may be copied, scanned, digitized,

converted to electronic portable document format ("pdf"), or otherwise reproduced and may be transmitted by digital or electronic transmission, including but not limited to facsimile transmission and electronic mail. Any signature affixed to this Order shall constitute an original signature for all purposes and may be used, filed, substituted, or issued for any purpose for which an original signature could be used. The term "signature" shall include manual signatures and true and accurate reproductions of manual signatures created, executed, endorsed, adopted, or authorized by the person or persons to whom the signatures are attributable. Signatures may be copied or reproduced digitally, electronically, by photocopying, engraving, imprinting, lithographing, electronic mail, facsimile transmission, stamping, or any other means or process which the Executive Director deems acceptable. In this paragraph exclusively, the terms: electronic transmission, owner, person, writing, and written, shall have the meanings assigned to them under Tex. Bus. Org. Code § 1.002.

8. The effective date of this Order is the date it is signed by the Commission. A copy of this fully executed Order shall be provided to each of the parties.
