Background and Current Practices

At the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, formal enforcement is handled within the Enforcement Division and the Litigation Division for all program media types. In order to provide an overview of agency-wide enforcement actions, a summary compiling each program's data is prepared for each month and is presented at a meeting of the Commission for which public notice is given. This report is required by Texas Water Code §7.003 - Enforcement Report.

Figure 1: Number of Notices of Violation

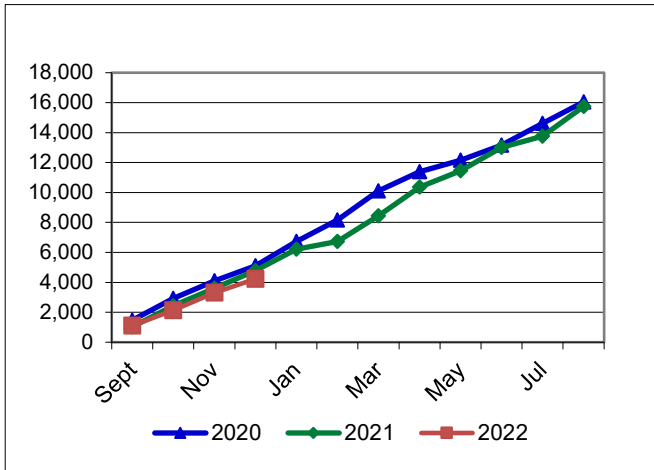


Figure 2: Number of Enforcement Action Referrals

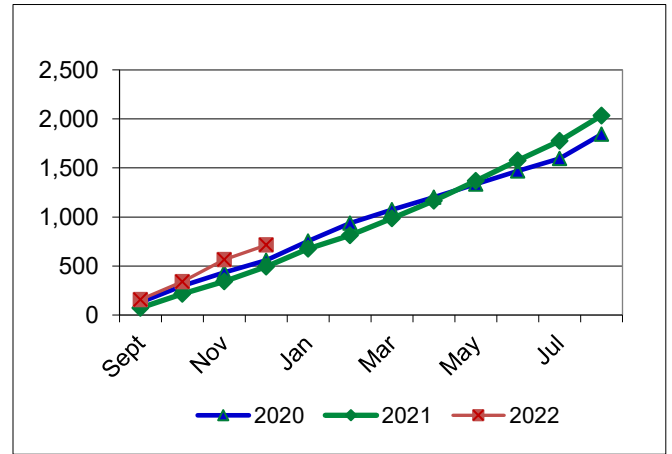


Figure 3: Number of Effective Orders

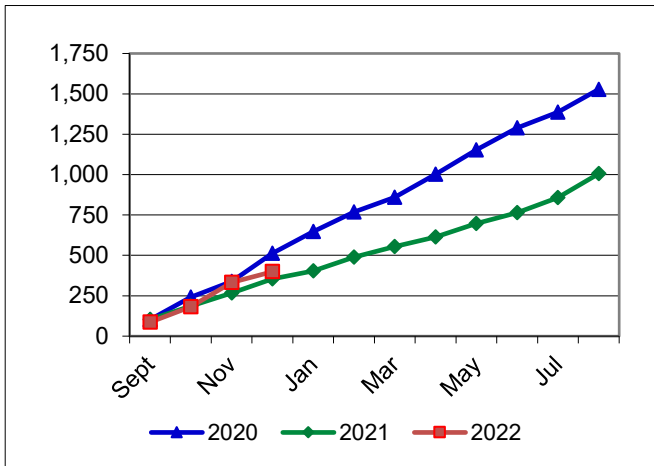


Figure 4: Assessed Penalties

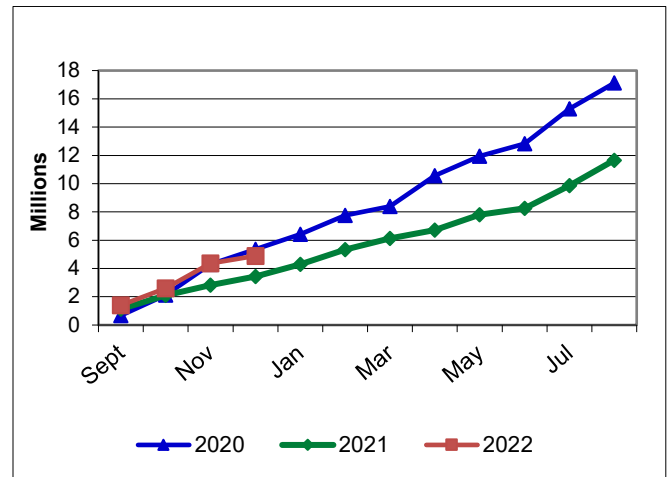


Figure 5: Supplemental Environmental Projects

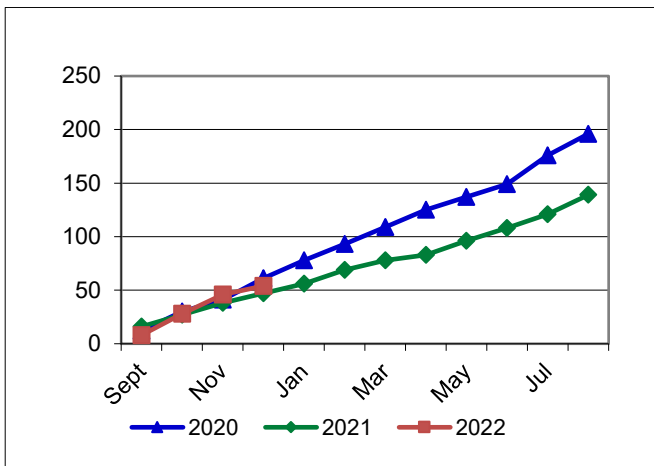


Figure 6: Number of Backlogged Orders

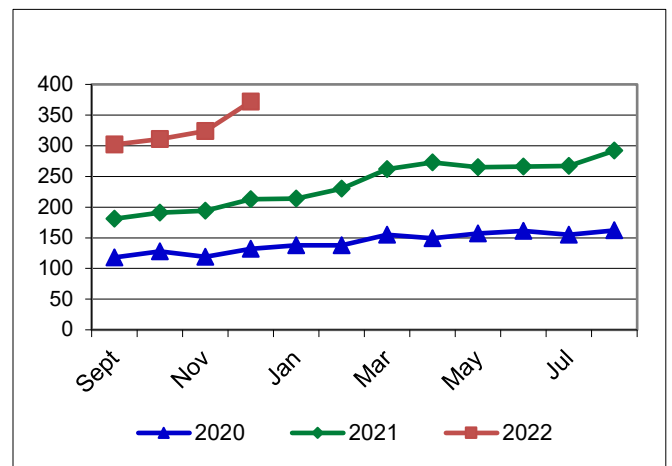


Figure 7: Summary

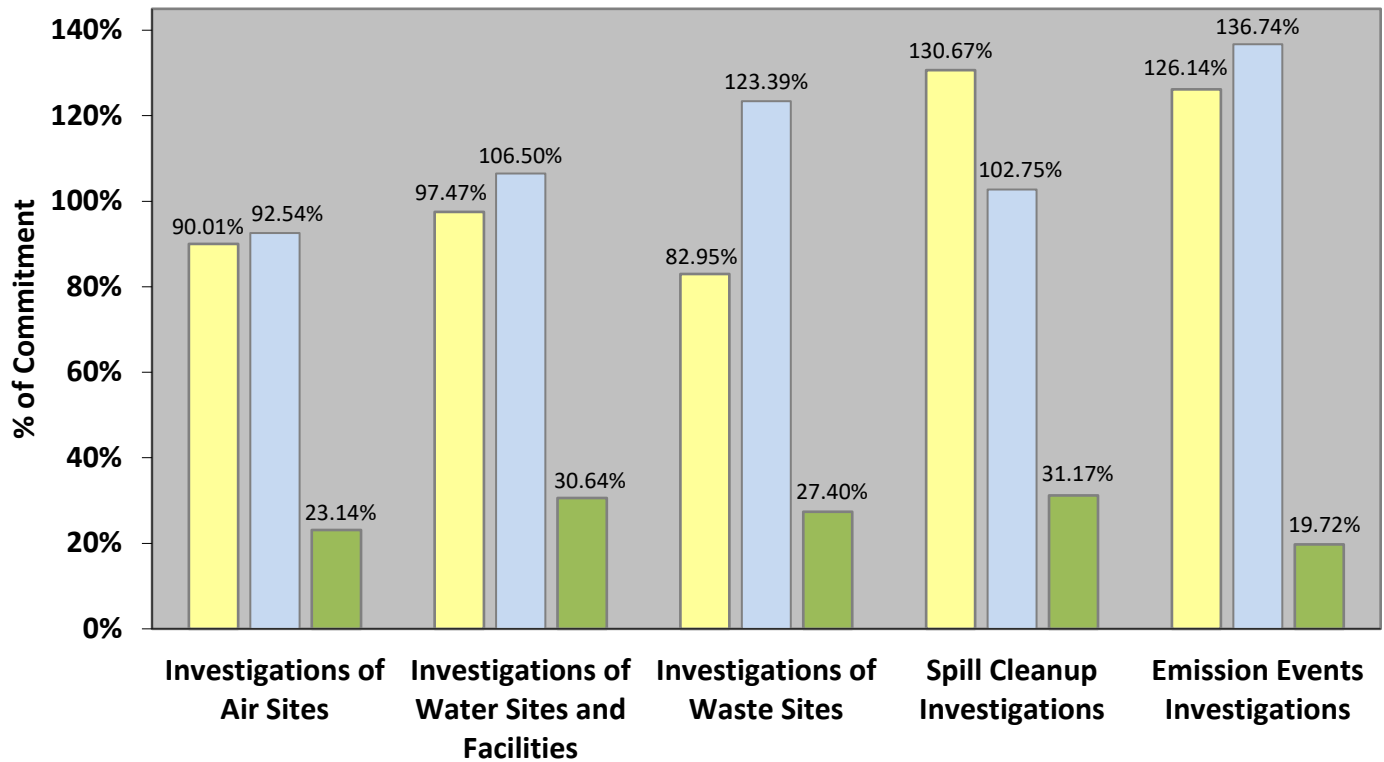
