Violation Information

- 1. Failed to ensure the Facility and all of its systems of collection, treatment, and disposal are properly operated and maintained. Specifically, corrosion was observed on both sides of the aeration basin and on the clarifier's effluent weirs [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Operational Requirements No. 1].
- 2. Failed to ensure the Facility and all of its systems of collection, treatment, and disposal are properly operated and maintained. Specifically, one of the two aerators in the effluent storage pond was not operational, tears were observed in the effluent storage pond liner, and a broken effluent irrigation nozzle was observed in the effluent application area [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Operational Requirements No. 1 and Special Provisions No. 16].
- 3. Failed to prevent an unauthorized discharge of sewage into or adjacent to any water in the state. Specifically, evidences of discharges were observed from the aeration basin and digester nos. 1 and 2 [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5), Tex. Water Code § 26.121(a)(1), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Permit Conditions No. 2.g].
- 4. Failed to design and manage the irrigation area to prevent ponding or surfacing of effluent or contamination of ground and surface waters and to prevent nuisance conditions. Specifically, multiple areas of effluent ponding were observed within the effluent application area (Barton Creek Lakeside Golf Course's driving range) [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Special Provisions No. 4].
- 5. Failed to maintain a minimum freeboard of two feet in the storage pond and failed to prevent an unauthorized discharge of treated wastewater into or adjacent to any water in the state. Specifically, two feet of freeboard was not maintained in the effluent

storage pond and treated wastewater was at, or flowing over the edge of the pond at six different points and an unauthorized discharge of approximately 1,500 gallons discharged from the effluent storage pond into a ditch on November 4, 2020 [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5), Tex. Water Code § 26.121(a)(2), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Operational Requirements No. 1, Special Provisions No. 7, and Permit Conditions 2.g].

- 6. Failed to monitor chlorine residual in the effluent at the point of irrigation application. Specifically, the Respondent was not verifying total chlorine residual by taking effluent samples at the point of irrigation after being held in the effluent storage pond [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5), Tex. Water Code § 26.121(a)(2), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Effluent Limitations and Monitoring Requirements A and Special Provision No. 11].
- 7. Failed to prevent an unauthorized discharge of treated wastewater into any water in the state. Specifically, approximately 1,000 gallons of treated wastewater discharged from irrigation pipes in the effluent application area and discharged onto an adjacent property [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5), Tex. Water Code § 26.121(a)(2), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Permit Conditions 2.g].
- 8. Failed to report an unauthorized discharge in writing to the Regional Office and the Enforcement Division within five working days of becoming aware of the noncompliance. Specifically, an unauthorized discharge was observed on October 26, 2020 and a noncompliance notification was not received until November 19, 2020 [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Monitoring Requirements No. 7.a].
- 9. Failed to install permanent transmission lines from the holding pond to each tract of land to be irrigated [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Special Provisions No. 15].

- iv. Develop and implement procedures to take effluent samples at the point of irrigation to verify total chlorine residual; and
- v. Repair the irrigation pipes in the effluent application area to cease unauthorized discharges.
- b. Within 45 days, submit written certification of compliance with a.
- c. Within 60 days:
- i. Repair/replace the aerator in the effluent storage pond;
- ii. Repair the tears in the effluent storage pond liner and conduct an evaluation of the Facility by a Texas Licensed Professional Engineer in order to meet the requirements of the liner certification; and
- iii. Modify and manage the irrigation area to prevent the ponding of effluent.
- d. Within 75 days, submit written certification of compliance with c.
- e. Within 90 days, install permanent transmission lines from the holding pond to each tract of land to be irrigated.
- f. Within 105 days, submit written certification of compliance with e.
- g. Within 180 days, construct and put into operation the new wastewater treatment facility.
- h. Within 195 days, submit written certification to demonstrate compliance with g.

I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

On,	the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the
Commission" or "TCEQ") conside	ered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement
action regarding Aqua Texas, Inc	c. (the "Respondent") under the authority of TEX. WATER CODE
chs. 7 and 26. The Executive Dir	ector of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and the
Respondent together stipulate th	at:

- 1. The Respondent owns and operates a wastewater treatment facility and disposal site located at Haynie Flat Road, approximately two miles north of the intersection of State Highway 71 and Haynie Road in Travis County, Texas (the "Facility"). The Facility is near or adjacent to water in the state as defined in Tex. Water Code § 26.001(5).
- 2. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree that the TCEQ has jurisdiction to enter this Order pursuant to Tex. Water Code §§ 7.002, 7.051, and 7.073, and that the Respondent is subject to TCEQ's jurisdiction. The TCEQ has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 5.013 because it alleges violations of Tex. Water Code ch. 26 and the rules of the TCEQ.
- 3. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Order shall not constitute an admission by the Respondent of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.
- 4. An administrative penalty in the amount of \$41,812 is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). The Respondent paid \$33,450 of the penalty and \$8,362 is deferred contingent upon the Respondent's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Order. The deferred amount shall be waived only upon full compliance with all the terms and conditions contained in this Order. If the Respondent fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with any of the terms or requirements contained in this Order, the Executive Director may demand payment of all or part of the deferred penalty amount.
- 5. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to final approval in accordance with 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(a). Any notice and procedures, which might otherwise be authorized or

required in this action, are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.

- 6. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that the Respondent has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Order.
- 7. This Order represents the complete and fully-integrated agreement of the parties. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.
- 8. This Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, whichever is later.
- 9. The Executive Director recognizes that the Respondent submitted a written noncompliance notification on November 19, 2020.

II. ALLEGATIONS

During an investigation conducted on October 26, 2020 through November 30, 2020, an investigator documented that the Respondent:

- 1. Failed to ensure the Facility and all of its systems of collection, treatment, and disposal are properly operated and maintained, in violation of 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 305.125(1) and (5), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Operational Requirements No. 1. Specifically, corrosion was observed on both sides of the aeration basin and on the clarifier's effluent weirs.
- 2. Failed to ensure the Facility and all of its systems of collection, treatment, and disposal are properly operated and maintained, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Operational Requirements No. 1 and Special Provisions No. 16. Specifically, one of the two aerators in the effluent storage pond was not operational, tears were observed in the effluent storage pond liner, and a broken effluent irrigation nozzle was observed in the effluent application area.
- 3. Failed to prevent an unauthorized discharge of sewage into or adjacent to any water in the state, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5), Tex. Water Code § 26.121(a)(1), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Permit Conditions No. 2.g. Specifically, evidences of discharges were observed from the aeration basin and digester nos. 1 and 2.
- 4. Failed to design and manage the irrigation area to prevent ponding or surfacing of effluent or contamination of ground and surface waters and to prevent nuisance conditions, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Special Provisions No. 4. Specifically, multiple areas of effluent ponding were observed within the effluent application area (Barton Creek Lakeside Golf Course's driving range).

- 5. Failed to maintain a minimum freeboard of two feet in the storage pond and failed to prevent an unauthorized discharge of treated wastewater into or adjacent to any water in the state, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5), Tex. Water Code § 26.121(a)(2), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Operational Requirements No. 1, Special Provisions No. 7, and Permit Conditions 2.g. Specifically, two feet of freeboard was not maintained in the effluent storage pond and treated wastewater was at, or flowing over the edge of the pond at six different points and an unauthorized discharge of approximately 1,500 gallons discharged from the effluent storage pond into a ditch on November 4, 2020.
- 6. Failed to monitor chlorine residual in the effluent at the point of irrigation application, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5), Tex. Water Code § 26.121(a)(2), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Effluent Limitations and Monitoring Requirements A and Special Provision No. 11. Specifically, the Respondent was not verifying total chlorine residual by taking effluent samples at the point of irrigation after being held in the effluent storage pond.
- 7. Failed to prevent an unauthorized discharge of treated wastewater into any water in the state, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and (5), Tex. Water Code § 26.121(a)(2), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Permit Conditions 2.g. Specifically, approximately 1,000 gallons of treated wastewater discharged from irrigation pipes in the effluent application area and discharged onto an adjacent property.
- 8. Failed to report an unauthorized discharge in writing to the Regional Office and the Enforcement Division within five working days of becoming aware of the noncompliance, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Monitoring Requirements No. 7.a. Specifically, an unauthorized discharge was observed on October 26, 2020 and a noncompliance notification was not received until November 19, 2020.
- 9. Failed to install permanent transmission lines from the holding pond to each tract of land to be irrigated, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Special Provisions No. 15.

III. DENIALS

The Respondent generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ORDERS that:

1. The Respondent is assessed a penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph No. 4. The payment of this penalty and the Respondent's compliance with all of the requirements set forth in this Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. Penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEO"

and shall be sent with the notation "Re: Aqua Texas, Inc., Docket No. 2021-0476-MWD-E" to:

- 2. The Respondent shall undertake the following technical requirements:
 - a. Within 30 days after the effective date of this Order:
 - i. Replace the broken effluent irrigation nozzle;
 - ii. Remove and properly clean up the discharges around the aeration basin and digester nos. 1 and 2;
 - iii. Develop and implement procedures to maintain two feet of freeboard in the effluent storage pond to prevent unauthorized discharges;
 - iv. Develop and implement procedures to take effluent samples at the point of irrigation to verify total chlorine residual; and
 - v. Repair the irrigation pipes in the effluent application area to cease unauthorized discharges.
 - b. Within 45 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification of compliance with Ordering Provision Nos. 2.a.i through 2.a.v, in accordance with Ordering Provision No. 2.h below.
 - c. Within 60 days after the effective date of this Order:
 - i. Repair/replace the aerator in the effluent storage pond;
 - ii. Repair the tears in the effluent storage pond liner and conduct an evaluation of the Facility by a Texas Licensed Professional Engineer in order to meet the requirements of the liner certification, in accordance with TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Special Provisions No. 16; and
 - iii. Modify and manage the irrigation area to prevent the ponding of effluent, in accordance with TCEQ Permit No. WQ0013477001, Special Provisions No. 4.
 - d. Within 75 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification of compliance with Ordering Provision Nos. 2.c.i through 2.c.iii, in accordance with Ordering Provision No. 2.h below.
 - e. Within 90 days after the effective date of this Order, install permanent transmission lines from the holding pond to each tract of land to be irrigated.

- f. Within 105 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification of compliance with Ordering Provision No. 2.e, in accordance with Ordering Provision No. 2.h below.
- g. Within 180 days after the effective date of this Order, construct and put into operation the new wastewater treatment facility.
- h. Within 195 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification, and include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provision No.
 2.g. The certification shall be signed by the Respondent and shall include the following certification language:

"I certify under penalty of law that I have personally examined and am familiar with the information submitted and all attached documents, and that based on my inquiry of those individuals immediately responsible for obtaining the information, I believe that the submitted information is true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for knowing violations."

- 3. All relief not expressly granted in this Order is denied.
- 4. The duties and provisions imposed by this Order shall apply to and be binding upon the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to give notice of this Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Facility operations referenced in this Order.
- 5. If the Respondent fails to comply with any of the Ordering Provisions in this Order within the prescribed schedules, and that failure is caused solely by an act of God, war, strike, riot, or other catastrophe, the Respondent's failure to comply is not a violation of this Order. The Respondent shall have the burden of establishing to the Executive Director's satisfaction that such an event has occurred. The Respondent shall notify the

Executive Director within seven days after the Respondent becomes aware of a delaying event and shall take all reasonable measures to mitigate and minimize any delay.

- 6. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by the Respondent shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until the Respondent receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director. Extension requests shall be sent to the Order Compliance Team at the address listed above.
- 7. This Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
- 8. This Order may be executed in separate and multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single instrument. Any page of this Order may be copied, scanned, digitized, converted to electronic portable document format ("pdf"), or otherwise reproduced and may be transmitted by digital or electronic transmission, including but not limited to facsimile transmission and electronic mail. Any signature affixed to this Order shall constitute an original signature for all purposes and may be used, filed, substituted, or issued for any purpose for which an original signature could be used. The term "signature" shall include manual signatures and true and accurate reproductions of manual signatures created, executed, endorsed, adopted, or authorized by the person or persons to whom the signatures are attributable. Signatures may be copied or reproduced digitally, electronically, by photocopying, engraving, imprinting, lithographing, electronic mail, facsimile transmission, stamping, or any other means or process which the Executive Director deems acceptable. In this paragraph exclusively, the terms: electronic transmission, owner, person, writing, and written, shall have the meanings assigned to them under TEX. BUS. ORG. CODE § 1.002.
- 9. The effective date of this Order is the date it is signed by the Commission. A copy of this fully executed Order shall be provided to each of the parties.
