I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

On	, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the
Commission" or "TO	EQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement
action regarding the	City of Wilmer (the "Respondent") under the authority of TEX. WATER CODE
chs. 7 and 26. The H	executive Director of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and the
Respondent togethe	r stipulate that:

- 1. The Respondent owns and operates a municipal separate storm sewer system located in the area within the City of Wilmer limits that is located within the Dallas Fort Worth Arlington urbanized area in Dallas County, Texas (the "Site"). The Site is near or adjacent to water in the state as defined in Tex. WATER CODE § 26.001(5).
- 2. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree that the TCEQ has jurisdiction to enter this Order pursuant to Tex. Water Code §§ 7.002, 7.051, and 7.073, and that the Respondent is subject to TCEQ's jurisdiction. The TCEQ has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 5.013 because it alleges violations of Tex. Water Code ch. 26 and the rules of the TCEQ.
- 3. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Order shall not constitute an admission by the Respondent of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.
- 4. An administrative penalty in the amount of \$25,000 is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). The Respondent paid \$20,000 of the penalty and \$5,000 is deferred contingent upon the Respondent's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Order. The deferred amount shall be waived only upon full compliance with all the terms and conditions contained in this Order. If the Respondent fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with any of the terms or requirements contained in this Order, the Executive Director may demand payment of all or part of the deferred penalty amount.
- 5. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to final approval in accordance with 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(a). Any notice and procedures, which might otherwise be authorized or

required in this action, are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.

- 6. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that the Respondent has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Order.
- 7. This Order represents the complete and fully-integrated agreement of the parties. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.
- 8. This Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, whichever is later.

II. ALLEGATIONS

During a record review conducted on April 28, 2021, an investigator documented that the Respondent:

- 1. Failed to maintain authorization to discharge stormwater under Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("TPDES") General Permit for municipal separate storm sewer systems, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 281.25(a)(4), Tex. Water Code § 26.121, and 40 Code of Federal Regulations § 122.26(a)(9)(i)(A). Specifically, TPDES General Permit No. TXR040000 expired on December 13, 2018 and the Respondent failed to submit a Notice of Intent ("NOI") and a Stormwater Management Plan ("SWMP") by the permit application deadline of July 23, 2019.
- 2. Failed to submit concise annual reports to the Executive Director within 90 days of the end of each reporting year, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 305.125(1) and expired TPDES General Permit No. TXR040635, Part IV, Section B(2). Specifically, the Respondent did not submit annual reports for the years 2018 and 2019.

III. DENIALS

The Respondent generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ORDERS that:

1. The Respondent is assessed a penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph No. 4. The payment of this penalty and the Respondent's compliance with all of the requirements set forth in this Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. Penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: City of Wilmer, Docket No. 2021-0684-WQ-E" to:

- 2. The Respondent shall undertake the following technical requirements:
 - a. Immediately and until such time that authorization to discharge stormwater is obtained, or until 180 days, whichever is earlier, comply with the permit requirements in expired TPDES General Permit No. TXR040635.
 - b. Within 30 days after the effective date of this Order:
 - i. Submit an NOI and SWMP to:

Applications Review and Processing Team Water Quality Division, MC 148 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality P.O. Box 13087 Austin, Texas 78711-3087

Respond completely and adequately, as determined by the TCEQ, to all requests for information concerning the permit application within 30 days after the date of such requests or by any other deadline specified in writing.

- ii. Develop and implement procedures and conduct employee training to submit annual reports to the Executive Director within 90 days of the end of each reporting year.
- iii. Submit the 2019 annual report to the Executive Director.
- c. Within 45 after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification, and include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provision Nos. 2.b.ii and 2.b.iii, in accordance with Ordering Provision No. 2.d.
- d. Within 180 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification that authorization to discharge stormwater has been obtained. The certification shall be signed by the Respondent and shall include the following certification language:

"I certify under penalty of law that I have personally examined and am familiar with the information submitted and all attached documents, and that based on my inquiry of those individuals immediately responsible for obtaining the information, I believe that the submitted information is true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false

information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for knowing violations."

- 3. All relief not expressly granted in this Order is denied.
- 4. The duties and provisions imposed by this Order shall apply to and be binding upon the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to give notice of this Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Site operations referenced in this Order.
- 5. If the Respondent fails to comply with any of the Ordering Provisions in this Order within the prescribed schedules, and that failure is caused solely by an act of God, war, strike, riot, or other catastrophe, the Respondent's failure to comply is not a violation of this Order. The Respondent shall have the burden of establishing to the Executive Director's satisfaction that such an event has occurred. The Respondent shall notify the Executive Director within seven days after the Respondent becomes aware of a delaying event and shall take all reasonable measures to mitigate and minimize any delay.
- 6. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by the Respondent shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until the Respondent receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director. Extension requests shall be sent to the Order Compliance Team at the address listed above.
- 7. This Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
- 8. This Order may be executed in separate and multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single instrument. Any page of this Order may be copied, scanned, digitized, converted to electronic portable document format ("pdf"), or otherwise reproduced and

may be transmitted by digital or electronic transmission, including but not limited to facsimile transmission and electronic mail. The term "signature" shall include manual signatures and true and accurate reproductions of manual signatures created, executed, endorsed, adopted, or authorized by the person or persons to whom the signatures are attributable. Signatures may be copied or reproduced digitally, electronically, by photocopying, engraving, imprinting, lithographing, electronic mail, facsimile transmission, stamping, or any other means or process which the Executive Director deems acceptable. In this paragraph exclusively, the terms: electronic transmission, owner, person, writing, and written, shall have the meanings assigned to them under Tex. Bus. Org. Code § 1.002.
