## **Violation Information**

1. Failed to comply with the maximum allowable emissions rate ("MAER") and failed to comply with the emissions limit. Specifically, during a stack test conducted on November 14, 2019, the Respondent exceeded the particulate matter ("PM") MAER of 1.02 pounds per hour ("lb/hr") by 20.08 lbs/hr and the PM emissions limit of 0.040 grain per dry standard cubic foot ("g/dscf") by 0.070 g/dscf for the Dryer Baghouse Stack, Emissions Point Number ("EPN") 11, resulting in approximately 87,709.44 pounds of unauthorized PM emissions [30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 101.20(1) and 116.115(b)(2)(F) and (c), 40 CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS ("CFR") §§ 60.8(f)(1) and 60.732(a), New Source Review ("NSR") Permit No. 156623, Special Conditions ("SC") No. 14, and TEX. CODE §§ 101.20(1) and 116.115(c), 40 CFR § 60.8(a), NSR Permit No. 156623, SC No. 14, and Tex. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 382.085(b)].

### AGREED ORDER DOCKET NO. 2021-1527-AIR-E

## I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

On \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the Commission" or "TCEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement action regarding JW Sands, LLC (the "Respondent") under the authority of TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE ch. 382 and TEX. WATER CODE ch. 7. The Executive Director of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and the Respondent together stipulate that:

- 1. The Respondent owns and operates a sand processing plant located at 22592 State Highway 16 South near Von Ormy, Bexar County, Texas (the "Plant"). The Plant consists or consisted of one or more sources as defined in Tex. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 382.003(12).
- 2. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree that the TCEQ has jurisdiction to enter this Order pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE §§ 7.002, 7.051, and 7.073, and that the Respondent is subject to TCEQ's jurisdiction. The TCEQ has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE § 5.013 because it alleges violations of TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE ch. 382 and the rules of the TCEQ.
- 3. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Order shall not constitute an admission by the Respondent of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.
- 4. An administrative penalty in the amount of \$131,000 assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). The Respondent paid \$104,800 of the penalty and \$26,200 is deferred contingent upon the Respondent's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Order. The deferred amount shall be waived only upon full compliance with all the terms and conditions contained in this Order. If the Respondent fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with any of the terms or requirements contained in this Order, the Executive Director may demand payment of all or part of the deferred penalty amount.
- 5. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to final approval in accordance with 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(a). Any notice and procedures, which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action, are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.

- 6. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that the Respondent has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Order.
- 7. This Order represents the complete and fully-integrated agreement of the parties. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.
- 8. This Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, whichever is later.
- 9. The Executive Director recognizes that on October 26, 2021, the Respondent submitted the performance test report for the performance test for Emissions Point Number ("EPN") 11 that was conducted on November 14, 2019.

### **II. ALLEGATIONS**

During an investigation conducted for the Plant on October 19, 2021, an investigator documented that the Respondent:

- 1. Failed to comply with the maximum allowable emissions rate ("MAER") and failed to comply with the emissions limit, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 101.20(1) and 116.115(b)(2)(F) and (c), 40 CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS ("CFR") §§ 60.8(f)(1) and 60.732(a), New Source Review ("NSR") Permit No. 156623, Special Conditions ("SC") No. 14, and Tex. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 382.085(b). Specifically, during a stack test conducted on November 14, 2019, the Respondent exceeded the particulate matter ("PM") MAER of 1.02 pounds per hour ("lb/hr") by 20.08 lbs/hr and the PM emissions limit of 0.040 grain per dry standard cubic foot ("g/dscf) by 0.070 g/dscf for the Dryer Baghouse Stack, EPN 11, resulting in approximately 87,709.44 pounds of unauthorized PM emissions.
- 2. Failed to submit a copy of each performance test report within 60 days after the test has been completed, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 101.20(1) and 116.115(c), 40 CFR § 60.8(a), NSR Permit No. 156623, SC No. 14, and Tex. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 382.085(b). Specifically, a performance test for EPN 11 was conducted on November 14, 2019 and the performance test report was due by January 13, 2020, but was not submitted.

### **III. DENIALS**

The Respondent generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

### **IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS**

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ORDERS that:

1. The Respondent is assessed a penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph No. 4. The payment of this penalty and the Respondent's compliance with all of the requirements set forth in this Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for

violations which are not raised here. Penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: JW Sands, LLC, Docket No. 2021-1527-AIR-E" to:

- 2. The Respondent shall undertake the following technical requirements at the Plant:
  - a. Within 15 days after the effective date of this Order, submit a notification to the Air Section Manager at the address in Ordering Provision No. 2.e to schedule a pretest meeting prior to conducting stack sampling.
  - b. Within 60 days after the effective date of this order, conduct a stack test demonstrating compliance with the PM MAER and PM emissions limit for EPN 11.
  - c. Within 75 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provision No. 2.b, as described in Ordering Provision No. 2.e.
  - d. Within 105 days after the effective date of this Order, submit copies of the final sampling report to the Air Section Manager at the address in Ordering Provision No. 2.e.
  - e. Within 120 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification, and include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provision No. 2.d. The certification shall be signed by the Respondent and shall include the following certification language:

"I certify under penalty of law that I have personally examined and am familiar with the information submitted and all attached documents, and that based on my inquiry of those individuals immediately responsible for obtaining the information, I believe that the submitted information is true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for knowing violations."

- 3. All relief not expressly granted in this Order is denied.
- 4. The duties and provisions imposed by this Order shall apply to and be binding upon the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to give notice of this Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Plant operations referenced in this Order.
- 5. If the Respondent fails to comply with any of the Ordering Provisions in this Order within the prescribed schedules, and that failure is caused solely by an act of God, war, strike, riot, or other catastrophe, the Respondent's failure to comply is not a violation of this Order. The Respondent shall have the burden of establishing to the Executive Director's satisfaction that such an event has occurred. The Respondent shall notify the Executive Director within seven days after the Respondent becomes aware of a delaying event and shall take all reasonable measures to mitigate and minimize any delay.
- 6. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by the Respondent shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until the Respondent receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director. Extension requests shall be sent to the Enforcement Division at the address listed above.
- 7. This Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
- 8. This Order may be executed in separate and multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single instrument. Any page of this Order may be copied, scanned. digitized, converted to electronic portable document format ("pdf"), or otherwise reproduced and may be transmitted by digital or electronic transmission, including but not limited to facsimile transmission and electronic mail. Any signature affixed to this Order shall constitute an original signature for all purposes and may be used, filed, substituted, or issued for any purpose for which an original signature could be used. The term "signature" shall include manual signatures and true and accurate reproductions of manual signatures created, executed, endorsed, adopted, or authorized by the person or persons to whom the signatures are attributable. Signatures may be copied or reproduced digitally, electronically, by photocopying, engraving, imprinting, lithographing, electronic mail, facsimile transmission, stamping, or any other means or process which the Executive Director deems acceptable. In this paragraph exclusively, the terms: electronic transmission, owner, person, writing, and written, shall have the meanings assigned to them under TEX. BUS. ORG. CODE § 1.002.

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9. The effective date of this Order is the date it is signed by the Commission. A copy of this fully executed Order shall be provided to each of the parties.
