At the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, formal enforcement is handled within the Enforcement Division and the Litigation Division for all program media types. This report is required by Texas Water Code §7.003 -Enforcement Report.

#### Figure 1: Number of Notices of Violation





Figure 3: Number of Effective Orders



**Figure 5: Supplemental Environmental Projects** 




Figure 2: Number of Enforcement Action Referrals




Figure 4: Assessed Penalties





Figure 6: Number of Backlogged Orders


