### H. GEAA'S Comments

GVSUD Failed to Provide Information and Conduct Analysis Relating to the Existing Utility Providers in the Region and Costs of Connecting to Pre-Existing Services

GVSUD has not adequately demonstrated that the requested permit is compliant with the TCEQ rules on regionalization for the Cibolo Creek Region, found at 30 Tex. Admin. Code. § 351.61-65.

The Texas Water Code encourages and promotes the development and use of regional waste treatment systems. TCEQ regulations provide that new discharge permits within the Cibolo Creek regional area shall only be issued to the Cibolo Creek Municipal Authority, a designated regional wastewater provider.2

TCEQ regulations define the Cibolo Creek regional area as encompassing parts of the Cibolo Creek Watershed lying in the vicinity of numerous cities, including the City of Schertz. GVSUD's permit application states the Facility will serve planned residential and commercial growth in GVSUD's sewer CCN area, which is located at least partially in the city of Schertz. Given that the facility is intended to serve an area within the area designated for service by Cibolo Creek Municipal Authority, issuance of the permit to GVSUD violates 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 351.65.3

While the violation of Rule 351.65 itself bars issuance of the permit, GVSUD also did not provide complete information otherwise related to regionalization. The permit application does not indicate whether any Cities in the vicinity are willing and able to provide wastewater service to the proposed service area, as required in Technical Reports Section 1.B. In addition, GVSUD did not provide information related to the costs of connecting with other utilities in the area. Cost analysis allows for a determination as to whether the Facility is needed given other treatment options available. GVSUD's answers to Section 1.B.2 and 1.B.3 of the Technical Reports in the permit application were incomplete, so the proper analysis cannot have been performed.

GVSUD states in its application that the service area for the facility is not within another utility's CCN area.<sup>5</sup> But, there is no map provided in the application to definitely bear out this claim. The only facts in the application—that the service area is partially in San Antonio, Schertz, and St. Hedwig—raise the strong possibility that the proposed service area is already served by an existing wastewater utility.

### Analysis of Need for this Project

The Texas Water Code authorizes the TCEQ, in considering the issuance of a permit to discharge waste, to deny or alter the terms and conditions of the proposed permit based on consideration of need, including the expected volume and quality of the influent and the availability of existing or

proposed areawide or regional waste treatment systems not designated by commission order.<sup>6</sup> In other words, need is relevant regardless of the regionalization analysis discussed above.

Available information in the permit application indicates there is not a demonstrated need for this Facility. GVSUD provides the following justification of need: "The requested permit is proposed to support planned residential and commercial growth in GVSUD's sewer CCN area. GVSUD holds sewer CCN for proposed service area. The current contract for service equates to 950 EDUs of service or 232,750 gp[d]." However, the draft permit authorizes a final phase of 400,000 gpd of wastewater discharge, almost twice as much as GVSUD says in its application there is a need for. The lack of need for the facility justifies denial of GVSUD's application.

## The Applicant Must Provide a Socioeconomic Justification for the Proposed Facility Pursuant to Tier 2 the State's Antidegradation Policy

Womans Hollow Creek meets Martinez Creek within three miles downstream of the discharge. See **Attachment A**. Martinez Creek is a perennial stream, according to TCEQ's 2020 Texas Integrated Reported on impaired water bodies. See **Attachment B**. This permit application triggers a full antidegradation review, which has not been performed yet.

Tier 1 of the Antidegradation Policy requires that existing uses and water quality sufficient to protect those existing uses must be maintained. Tier 2 of the Antidegradation Policy requires that no activities subject to regulatory action that would cause degradation of waters that exceed fishable/swimmable quality are allowed unless it can be shown to the commission's satisfaction that the lowering of water quality is necessary for important economic or social development.

Thus, in addition to the regionalization analysis, there must also be a Tier 2 analysis as to whether lowering water quality is necessary for important economic or social development.

This proposed discharge threatens to further degrade two water bodies already impaired for bacteria. Lower Cibolo Creek downstream of IH 10 until the confluence with the San Antonio River is an impaired water body for bacteria, listed in TCEQ's 2020 Texas Integrated Report for Clean Water Act Section 303(d) purposes. Martinez Creek is also a listed water body as impaired for bacteria. The GVSUD intends to eventually discharge 400,000 gallons per day into Womans Hollow Creek. This discharge has will increase bacteria content in those receiving water bodies.



transmit disease and infestations. bioaerosols are a major concern. In previous studies, using personal samplers, it was shown that sewage treatment plant employees that have a higher incidence of headache, tiredness, and nausea were exposed to culturable bacteria. Exposure to rod-shaped bacteria and total number of bacteria was significantly higher in workers reporting headache during work than in workers not reporting headache. A few studies have shown that blood tests of workers who were subjected to aerosol inhalation indicated an increased level of antibodies against Gram negative bacteria and intestinal viruses. The condition has been described as "the sewage worker's syndrome," which has a viral origin and manifests itself with a despondency, overall weakness, catarrh, and fever [11, 18]. Main characteristics of the disease included general malaise, weakness, acute rhinitis, and fever [19], accompanied by gastrointestinal symptoms. In accordance with these studies, we recorded increased odds for the inhabitants who lived near the WTP to develop neurological and myoskeletal symptoms at 3.37 and 1.98 times, respectively. Moreover, sewage workers and those who live in the vicinity of a WTP have higher morbidity with intestinal and respiratory system illnesses [11, 20]. In order to ensure public health, health of workers, and good quality of life, it is necessary to determine the composition and concentration of microorganisms in the air. Skin contact, ingestion, and inhalation are the three major routes of exposure to airborne particles [20]. Microorganisms that are associated with intestinal infections such as Salmonella spp. and enteric viruses are thought to be transmitted through inhalation [4, 21]. Also, a nationwide survey in Sweden showed that an increased risk for headache, concentration difficulties, unusual tiredness, and head heaviness was reported in workers compared to the controls [18]. Similarly, in our study, feelings like tiredness and sickness were more reported by the cases compared to the controls. Interestingly, our study showed an increased rate in mental disorders to the population living near the WTP. There was no significant correlation of the WTP and the occurrence of gastrointestinal or myoskeletal symptoms to the residents. Also, this study showed no significant correlation concerning gastrointestinal, allergic, and respiratory symptoms although the study sample of the controls was rather small due to the refusal of controls (people in the city) to participate in the study. In our study, there is a significant presence of possible pathogenic microorganisms in the aerosols close to WTP and this concentration depended on the distance. There is indication of the burden of microorganisms in air according to the distance of the inhabitants. To establish aerosols impact on the human health, more extensive studies are needed including medical examinations in inhabitants. Such studies have not been performed to the area of the WTP. In order to lower the impact for public health, in areas like this, retaliatory preventive measures should be taken by the authorities in order to protect inhabitant's health. Such measures could be considered the tree growing around the WTP as well as the appropriate function of the WTP with protective equipment for the aerosols. A significant part of the community engages in agriculture including raising cattle and other farm animals It is

unconscionable to introduce the environmental hazards that a waste treatment plant would present into such an agricultural rural community. The bacteria and soil contaminants that the plant would expel could destroy the livelihoods of these farming and ranching families. The immense amount of contaminated water that will be released into the creeks will not only endanger the farm animals and wildlife in the area, but also increase the likelihood of flooding homes, roads, and farmland. The residents in this pristine rural community would also have the odor of chemicals and sewage introduced into their lives, their children's lives, and on their property. The residents in the area of this proposed plant use septic tanks, therefore they will not receive any benefit from the plant. St. Hedwig will only receive the poison from the plant. Green Valley SUD proposing to build this plant, to benefit a new subdivision, in such a pristine rural community shows their disdain and antipathy towards the rural community in Bexar County. The City of St. Hedwig contends that Green Valley SUD's application for the permit includes incorrect statements and does not comply with the State's regionalization policy. The city is not convinced Green Valley SUD has justified the excessive and unnecessary amount of untreated effluent to be generated and has not satisfied water quality, antidegradation, and stream standard requirements. The residents of St. Hedwig request that TCEQ deny the application and draft permit by Green Valley SUD.
