Construction of the proposed Lake Ringgold in Clay County, Texas

This letter is in response to the recommendations of the Applicant and TCEQ Executive Director that my request for a contested case hearing in Docket No. 2022-0125-WR be denied.

My property is located at 12663 State Highway 148 N, Henrietta, Texas 76365. I jointly own property with my brother, Jason Obermier, at this address, and his request for a contested case hearing was granted. Our property is in the footprint and floodplain of the proposed Lake Ringgold.

The ED recommended my brother's request saying "However, property interests in land impacted by inundation relate directly to the reservoir, which is within the Commission's jurisdiction, therefore the Executive Director Recommends granting the request". See #19 – Jason Obermier under RECOMMENDATIONS TO GRANT/Property owners – inundation.

The OPIC determined that I was "an affected person" citing "The ED has prepared a map in this case demonstrating that Mr. Obermier's property is within or near the footprint of the proposed facility. Due to the location of the property and the concerns raised, the requestor has demonstrated a personal justiciable interest related to a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest not common to that of the general public. Therefore, OPIC finds that Jimmy Dale Obermier is an affected person. See page 12, m. Jimmy Dale Obermier in the OPIC's Response to Hearing Requests correspondence dated 03.21.22.

For these reasons, I ask that my request for a contested case hearing be recommended and granted.
