On behalf of the City of Henrietta, I am requesting a contested case hearing of Permit No. WRPERM 13404, the application by the City of Wichita Falls for a large water right, use of the bed and banks of the Little Wichita River, and the construction of the proposed Lake Ringgold.

The City of Henrietta appropriates water from the Little Wichita River as authorized under Texas Water Rights Commission, Permits No. 276, No. 913, and No. 1678. The City of Henrietta's permitted point of diversion and our intake structure will be affected by building Lake Ringgold. Both the diversion point and the intake structure are shown to be within the Conservation Pool of the proposed Lake Ringgold project.

The City of Henrietta currently has two wastewater plants that could possibly be affected by the project. Though The City of Henrietta is planning and working toward construction of a new wastewater treatment plant in the future, we are concerned we will be forced to go from secondary to tertiary treatment with the construction of Lake Ringgold.

The cost of displacement to property owners, as well as cost to properly provide adequate services to residents would be both an unnecessary expense and unfair to tax payers. The permit the City of Wichita Falls is requesting should be unequivocally denied.

In the event modifications are found necessary to the City of Henrietta's diversion and intake structure or wastewater plants, the cost of such modifications shall be borne at the sole expense of the City of Wichita Falls.

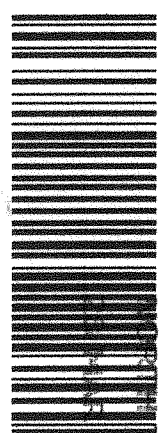

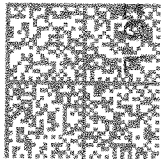
