RE: SOAH Docket No. 582-22-2634; TCEQ Docket No. 2022-0125-WR; Application of the City of Wichita Falls for Water Use Permit No. WRPERM 13404, in Archer, Clay, and Wichita Counties, Texas.

The above-referenced matter is scheduled to be considered by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on **Friday, May 10, 2024** at **9:30 A.M.** Due to an ongoing construction project impacting TCEQ's meeting spaces, the agenda meeting will be held in **Room 244 of the Texas Workforce Commission** located at 101 East 15th Street in Austin, Texas, virtually, or both in person and virtually. Pursuant to 30 TAC § 80.263, in proceedings where a judge has held a public hearing and has issued a proposal for decision or other report to the commission, all oral presentations before the commission shall be limited to five minutes each, excluding time for answering questions, unless the chairman or general counsel establishes other limitations.

The General Counsel has directed me to extend the time for oral argument to **ten minutes** for the Applicant; **ten minutes** for the Protestants collectively; **five minutes** for the Executive Director; and **five minutes** for the Office of Public Interest Counsel. The Protestants should apportion their ten minutes among themselves before the public meeting and contact Mehgan Taack, Office of the Chief Clerk at (512) 239-3300 by **5:00 p.m.** on **Wednesday, May 8, 2024**, to let her know how the time will be apportioned. The Applicant may save part of its time for rebuttal, as it bears the burden of proof. Parties should present their arguments on the Proposal for Decision during their allotted oral argument time.
