

The protestants in this matter, Don Norwood and Castell Realty LLC appreciate the thoughtful analysis provided by both the Executive Director and Office of Public Interest Counsel ("OPIC") in their respective responses to hearing requests filed on May 9, 2022. Mr. Norwood agrees with both the Executive Director and OPIC that the Commission should grant his hearing request.

Castell Realty LLC also agrees with OPIC that its hearing request should likewise be granted. However, Castell Realty LLC respectfully disagrees with the Executive Director's recommendation that the Commission deny its hearing request. Castell Realty LLC respectfully requests that the Commission consider its arguments in its November 17, 2021 comment letter and its February 22, 2022 hearing request letter, both of which are available in the backup documents filed in your office by the Executive Director on May 13, 2022. Star Harbor did not file any response in opposition to the hearing requests filed in this matter. A decision to grant the permit requested by Star Harbor will adversely affect Castell Realty LLC.
