## Violation Information

- 1. Failed to comply with the emissions limit. Specifically, the Respondent exceeded the emissions limit of 0.00025 pound of chromium compounds per ton of glass pulled ("lb of Cr/ton of glass pulled") by 0.00004 lb of Cr/ton of glass pulled during a performance test completed on June 6, 2018 and by 0.00019 lb of Cr/ton of glass pulled during a performance test completed on August 15, 2018 for the V-1 Furnace Dry Electrostatic Precipitator Stack, Emissions Point Number ("EPN") 3, resulting in 1.46 pounds of unauthorized Cr emissions [30 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 101.20(2), 113.710, 116.115(c), and 122.143(4), 40 Code of Federal Regulations ("CFR") § 63.1382(a), New Source Review ("NSR") Permit No. 6093, Special Conditions ("SC") No. 3, Federal Operating Permit ("FOP") No. 01094, General Terms and Conditions ("GTC") and Special Terms and Conditions ("STC") Nos. 1.G. and 8, and Tex. - 2. Failed to submit the results of the performance tests within 60 days after the date of completing each performance test. Specifically, a performance test for the V-1 Furnace Dry Electrostatic Precipitator Stack was completed on August 15, 2018 and the results were due by October 14, 2018, but were not submitted until October 19, 2018 [30 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 101.20(2), 113.710, 116.115(c), and 122.143(4), 40 CFR §§ 63.12(c) and 63.1386(f), NSR Permit No. 6093, Special Conditions No. 3, FOP No. 01094, GTC and STC Nos. 1.G. and 8, and Tex. Health & Safety Code § 382.085(b)].

#### AGREED ORDER DOCKET NO. 2022-0422-AIR-E

#### I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

On, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the
Commission" or "TCEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement
action regarding Owens Corning Insulating Systems, LLC (the "Respondent") under the authority
of Tex. Health & Safety Code ch. 382 and Tex. Water Code ch. 7. The Executive Director of the
TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and the Respondent together stipulate that:

- 1. The Respondent owns and operates a wool fiberglass manufacturing plant located at 3700 North Interstate Highway 35 East in Waxahachie, Ellis County, Texas (the "Plant"). The Plant consists or consisted of one or more sources as defined in Tex. Health & Safety Code § 382.003(12).
- 2. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree that the TCEQ has jurisdiction to enter this Order pursuant to Tex. Water Code §§ 7.002, 7.051, and 7.073, and that the Respondent is subject to TCEQ's jurisdiction. The TCEQ has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 5.013 because it alleges violations of Tex. Health & Safety Code ch. 382 and the rules of the TCEQ.
- 3. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Order shall not constitute an admission by the Respondent of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.
- 4. An administrative penalty in the amount of \$21,875 is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). The Respondent paid \$21,875 of the penalty.
- 5. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to final approval in accordance with 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(a). Any notice and procedures, which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action, are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.
- 6. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that the Respondent has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Order.

- 7. This Order represents the complete and fully-integrated agreement of the parties. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.
- 8. This Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, whichever is later.
- 9. The Executive Director recognizes that the Respondent implemented the following corrective measures at the Plant:
  - a. On October 19, 2018, submitted the results of the performance test that was completed on August 15, 2018 for the V-1 Furnace Dry Electrostatic Precipitator Stack; and
  - b. On November 14, 2018, conducted a performance test demonstrating compliance with the emissions limit of 0.00025 pound of chromium compounds per ton of glass pulled ("lb of Cr/ton of glass pulled") for the V-1 Furnace Dry Electrostatic Precipitator, Emissions Point Number ("EPN") 3.

#### II. ALLEGATIONS

During a record review for the Plant conducted on September 7, 2021, an investigator documented that the Respondent:

- 1. Failed to comply with the emissions limit, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 101.20(2), 113.710, 116.115(c), and 122.143(4), 40 Code of Federal Regulations ("CFR") § 63.1382(a), New Source Review ("NSR") Permit No. 6093, Special Conditions ("SC") No. 3, Federal Operating Permit ("FOP") No. 01094, General Terms and Conditions ("GTC") and Special Terms and Conditions ("STC") Nos. 1.G. and 8, and Tex. Health & Safety Code § 382.085(b). Specifically, the Respondent exceeded the emissions limit of 0.00025 lb of Cr/ton of glass pulled by 0.00004 lb of Cr/ton of glass pulled during a performance test completed on June 6, 2018 and by 0.00019 lb of Cr/ton of glass pulled during a performance test completed on August 15, 2018 for the V-1 Furnace Dry Electrostatic Precipitator Stack, EPN 3, resulting in 1.46 pounds of unauthorized Cr emissions.
- 2. Failed to submit the results of the performance tests within 60 days after the date of completing each performance test, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 101.20(2), 113.710, 116.115(c), and 122.143(4), 40 CFR §§ 63.12(c) and 63.1386(f), NSR Permit No. 6093, Special Conditions No. 3, FOP No. 01094, GTC and STC Nos. 1.G. and 8, and Tex. Health & Safety Code § 382.085(b). Specifically, a performance test for the V-1 Furnace Dry Electrostatic Precipitator Stack was completed on August 15, 2018 and the results were due by October 14, 2018, but were not submitted until October 19, 2018.

#### III. DENIALS

The Respondent generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

#### IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ORDERS that:

1. The Respondent is assessed a penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph No. 4. The payment of this penalty and the Respondent's compliance with all of the requirements set forth in this Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. Penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: Owens Corning Insulating Systems, LLC, Docket No. 2022-0422-AIR-E" to:

- 2. All relief not expressly granted in this Order is denied.
- 3. The duties and provisions imposed by this Order shall apply to and be binding upon the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to give notice of this Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Plant operations referenced in this Order.
- 4. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by the Respondent shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until the Respondent receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director.
- 5. This Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
- 6. This Order may be executed in separate and multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single instrument. Any page of this Order may be copied, scanned, digitized, converted to electronic portable document format ("pdf"), or otherwise reproduced and may be transmitted by digital or electronic transmission, including but not limited to facsimile transmission and electronic mail. Any signature affixed to this Order shall constitute an original signature for all purposes and may be used, filed, substituted, or issued for any purpose for which an original signature could be used. The term "signature" shall include manual signatures and true and accurate reproductions of manual signatures created, executed, endorsed, adopted, or authorized by the person or persons to whom the signatures are attributable. Signatures may be copied or reproduced digitally, electronically, by photocopying, engraving, imprinting, lithographing, electronic mail, facsimile transmission, stamping, or any other means or process which the Executive Director deems acceptable. In this paragraph exclusively, the terms: electronic transmission, owner, person, writing, and written, shall have the meanings assigned to them under Tex. Bus. Org. Code § 1.002.
