- b. Within 45 days:
- i. Submit written certification a to demonstrate compliance with a.i.; and
- ii. Submit to the Commission a copy of the CCR provided to customers of the Facility and the certification that the CCR has been provided to the customers of the Facility and that the information in the CCR is correct and consistent with the compliance monitoring data.
- c. Within 60 days, submit written certification to demonstrate compliance with b.ii.

## AGREED ORDER DOCKET NO. 2022-0454-PWS-E

On	, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the
Commission" or "TO	CEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement
action regarding GL	ENDALE WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION (the "Respondent") under the
authority of Tex. WA	ATER CODE ch. 5 and TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE ch. 341. The Executive
Director of the TCE	Q, through the Enforcement Division, and the Respondent presented this
Order to the Comm	ission

The Respondent understands that they have certain procedural rights at certain points in the enforcement process, including the right to formal notice of violations, notice of an evidentiary hearing, the right to an evidentiary hearing, and a right to appeal. By entering into this Order, the Respondent agrees to waive all notice and procedural rights.

It is further understood and agreed that this Order represents the complete and fully-integrated agreement of the parties. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable. The duties and responsibilities imposed by this Order are binding upon the Respondent.

The Commission makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

#### I. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Respondent owns and operates a public water supply located at 10668 State Highway 94 near Trinity, Trinity County, Texas (the "Facility"). The Facility provides water for human consumption, has approximately 471 service connections, and serves at least 25 people per day for at least 60 days per year. As such, the Facility is a public water system as defined in 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.38(71).
- 2. During a record review for the Facility conducted on April 4, 2022 through April 15, 2022, an investigator documented that:
  - a. The Respondent did not provide the results of Stage 2 Disinfection Byproducts ("DBP2") sampling to the Executive Director for the third and fourth quarters of 2021;
  - b. The Respondent did not provide the results of synthetic organic chemical ("SOC") contaminants (Methods 504, 515, and 531) sampling to the Executive Director for the January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2021 monitoring period;

- c. The Respondent did not provide the results of nitrate and nitrite sampling to the Executive Director for the January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 monitoring period;
- d. The Respondent did not mail or directly deliver one copy of the Consumer Confidence Report ("CCR") to each bill paying customer by July 1 each year, and failed to submit to the TCEQ by July 1 for each year a copy of the annual CCR and certification that the CCR has been distributed to the customers of the Facility and that the information in the CCR is correct and consistent with compliance monitoring data for calendar year 2020;
- e. The 2019 CCR did not include the following: complete contact information, a Spanish contact number, disinfectant residual, and wholesale provider data;
- f. The Respondent did not provide a consumer notification of lead tap water monitoring results to persons served at the sites (taps) that were tested, and failed to mail a copy of the consumer notification of tap results to the Executive Director along with certification that the consumer notification has been distributed in a manner consistent with TCEQ requirements for the July 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 and January 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021 monitoring periods; and
- g. The Respondent did not provide the results of volatile organic chemical ("VOC") contaminants sampling to the Executive Director for the January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 monitoring period.
- 3. During a record review for the Facility conducted on April 19, 2022, an investigator documented that:
  - a. The Respondent did not pay regulatory assessment fees for the TCEQ Public Utility Account regarding Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11224 for calendar years 2021 through 2022; and
  - b. The Respondent did not pay annual Public Health Service fees and/or any associated late fees for TCEQ Financial Administration Account No. 92280012 for Fiscal Years 2022 through 2023.
- 4. The Executive Director recognizes that the Respondent implemented the following corrective measures at the Facility:
  - a. On April 19, 2022, reported the delinquent water chemical analysis results for nitrate and nitrite, DBP2 sampling, SOC contaminants (Methods 504, 515, and 531), and VOC contaminants sampling;
  - b. On July 29, 2022, provided consumer notification of lead tap water monitoring results; and
  - c. On August 9, 2022, submitted the corrected 2019 CCR.

#### II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 1, the Respondent is subject to the jurisdiction of the TCEQ pursuant to Tex. Water Code ch. 5, Tex. Health & Safety Code ch. 341, and the rules of the TCEQ.
- 2. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.a, the Respondent failed to provide the results of Stage 2 DBP2 sampling to the Executive Director, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN CODE § 290.115(e).
- 3. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.b, the Respondent failed to provide the results of SOC contaminants (Methods 504, 515, and 531) sampling to the Executive Director, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN CODE § 290.107(e).
- 4. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.c, the Respondent failed to provide the results of nitrate and nitrite sampling to the Executive Director, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN CODE § 290.106(e).
- 5. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.d, the Respondent failed to mail or directly deliver one copy of the CCR to each bill paying customer by July 1 each year, and failed to submit to the TCEQ by July 1 for each year a copy of the annual CCR and certification that the CCR has been distributed to the customers of the Facility and that the information in the CCR is correct and consistent with compliance monitoring data, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN CODE §§ 290.271(b) and 290.274(a) and (c).
- 6. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.e, the Respondent failed to meet the adequacy, availability, and/or content requirements for the CCR, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 290.272 and 290.274(a).
- 7. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.f, the Respondent failed to provide a consumer notification of lead tap water monitoring results to persons served at the sites (taps) that were tested, and failed to mail a copy of the consumer notification of tap results to the Executive Director along with certification that the consumer notification has been distributed in a manner consistent with TCEQ requirements, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.117(i)(6) and (j).
- 8. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.g, the Respondent failed to provide the results of VOC contaminants sampling to the Executive Director, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN CODE § 290.107(e).
- 9. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 3.a, the Respondent failed to pay regulatory assessment fees for the TCEQ Public Utility Account regarding Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11224, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 291.76 and Tex. Water Code § 5.702.
- 10. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 3.b, the Respondent failed to pay annual Public Health Service fees and/or any associated late fees for TCEQ Financial Administration Account No. 92280012, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.51(a)(6) and Tex. WATER CODE § 5.702.

- 11. Pursuant to Tex. Health & Safety Code § 341.049(a), the TCEQ has the authority to assess an administrative penalty against the Respondent for violations of state statutes within the TCEQ's jurisdiction, for violations of rules adopted under such statutes, or for violations of orders or permits issued under such statutes.
- An administrative penalty in the amount of \$8,250 is justified by the facts recited in this Order and considered in light of the factors set forth in Tex. Health & Safety Code § 341.049(b). The Respondent paid \$235 of the penalty. The remaining amount of \$8,015 shall be paid in 35 monthly payments of \$229 each. The first monthly payment shall be paid within 30 days after the effective date of this Order. The subsequent payments shall each be paid not later than 30 days following the due date of the previous payment until the penalty is paid in full. If the Respondent fails to comply with the payment requirements of this Order, including the payment schedule, the Executive Director may accelerate the maturity of the remaining installments, in which event the unpaid balance shall become immediately due and payable without demand or notice. The Respondent's failure to meet the payment schedule of this Order and/or the acceleration of any remaining balance constitutes the failure by the Respondent to timely and satisfactorily comply with all the terms and conditions of this Order and the Executive Director may demand payment of all or part of the deferred penalty amount.

#### III. ORDERING PROVISIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ORDERS that:

1. The Respondent is assessed a penalty as set forth in Conclusion of Law No. 12 for violations of state statutes and rules of the TCEQ. The payment of this penalty and the Respondent's compliance with all the requirements set forth in this Order resolve only the matters set forth by this Order in this action. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective actions or penalties for violations that are not raised here. Penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: GLENDALE WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION, Docket No. 2022-0454-PWS-E" to:

- 2. The Respondent shall undertake the following technical requirements:
  - a. Within 30 days after the effective date of this Order:
    - i. Mail or directly deliver one copy of the CCR prepared using the compliance data for the most recent calendar year to each bill paying customer and make a good faith effort to deliver the CCR to non-bill paying customers, in accordance with 30 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 290.271 and 290.274;

- ii. Submit payment for all outstanding regulatory assessment fees for the TCEQ Public Utility Account concerning Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11224 for calendar years 2021 through 2022. The payment, along with the associated Revenue and Regulatory Assessment Reports, shall be sent to the address listed in Ordering Provision No. 1; and
- Submit payment for all outstanding Public Health Service fees and/or any associated late fees for TCEQ Financial Administration Account No.
   92280012 for Fiscal Years 2022 through 2023. The payment, along with the associated Revenue and Regulatory Assessment Reports, shall be sent to the address listed in Ordering Provision No. 1.
- b. Within 45 days after the effective date of this Order:
  - i. Submit written certification as described in Ordering Provision No. 2.c below, and include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provision No. 2.a.i; and
  - ii. Submit to the Commission a copy of the CCR provided to customers of the Facility and the certification that the CCR has been provided to the customers of the Facility and that the information in the CCR is correct and consistent with the compliance monitoring data, in accordance with 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 290.274. The copy of the CCR and certification shall be mailed to:

c. Within 60 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification, and include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provision No. 2.b.ii. The certification shall be signed by the Respondent and shall include the following certification language:

"I certify under penalty of law that I have personally examined and am familiar with the information submitted and all attached documents, and that based on my inquiry of those individuals immediately responsible for obtaining the information, I believe that the submitted information is true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for knowing violations."

- 3. All relief not expressly granted in this Order is denied.
- 4. The duties and provisions imposed by this Order shall apply to and be binding upon the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to give notice of this Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Facility operations referenced in this Order.
- 5. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by the Respondent shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until the Respondent receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director. Extension requests shall be sent to the Enforcement Division at the address listed above.
- 6. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that the Respondent has not complied with one or more of the terms in this Order.
- 7. This Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, whichever is later.
- 8. This Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
- 9. This Order may be executed in separate and multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single instrument. Any page of this Order may be copied, scanned, digitized, converted to electronic portable document format ("pdf"), or otherwise reproduced and may be transmitted by digital or electronic transmission, including but not limited to facsimile transmission and electronic mail. Any signature affixed to this Order shall constitute an original signature for all purposes and may be used, filed,

substituted, or issued for any purpose for which an original signature could be used. The term "signature" shall include manual signatures and true and accurate reproductions of manual signatures created, executed, endorsed, adopted, or authorized by the person or persons to whom the signatures are attributable. Signatures may be copied or reproduced digitally, electronically, by photocopying, engraving, imprinting, lithographing, electronic mail, facsimile transmission, stamping, or any other means or process which the Executive Director deems acceptable.
