### What the adopted action would do:

This action will approve the rules review of Chapter 30, and readopt the chapter.

This action constitutes a determination by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, after opportunity for public review and comment, that the initial reasons for adopting the rules of this chapter continue to exist.

#### Applicable law:

The review of the rules is authorized under the requirements of Texas Government Code, §2001.039; and the General Appropriations Act, Article IX, §9-10.13, 76th Texas Legislature, 1999, which require state agencies to review and consider for readoption each of their rules every four years.

#### Reason rules are needed:

Executive director's staff conducted a review of the rules in Chapter 30 and determined that the reasons for adopting these rules continue to exist. Regulation in the form of licensing for individuals engaged in environmental occupations is necessary to ensure that qualified individuals and entities are performing safe and effective operations and to prevent adverse impacts on human health and the environment.

Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Chapter 30 – Occupational Licenses and Registrations Non-Rule Project No. 2023-018-WS

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (commission) has completed its Rule Review of 30 TAC Chapter 30, Occupational Licenses and Registrations, as required by Texas Government Code, §2001.039. Texas Government Code, §2001.039, requires a state agency to review and consider for readoption, readoption with amendments, or repeal each of its rules every four years. The commission published its Notice of Intent to Review these rules in the January 20, 2023, issue of the *Texas Register* (48 TexReg 230).

The review assessed whether the initial reasons for adopting the rules continue to exist and the commission has determined that those reasons exist. The rules in Chapter 30 are required because regulation in the form of licensing for individuals engaged in environmental occupations is necessary to ensure that qualified individuals and entities are performing safe and effective operations and to prevent adverse impacts on human health and the environment.

#### **Public Comment**

The public comment period closed on February 21, 2023. The commission did not receive comments on the rules review of this chapter.

As a result of the review the commission finds that the reasons for adopting the rules in 30 TAC Chapter 30 continue to exist and readopts these sections in accordance with the requirements of Texas Government Code, §2001.039.

#### ORDER ADOPTING RULES REVIEW AND READOPTING RULES
