RE: Duck Creek Municipal Utility District of Denton County; Requests filed regarding Creation; TCEQ Docket No. 2022-1631-DIS; SOAH Docket No. 582-23-13330.

The above-referenced matter is scheduled to be considered by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ or Commission) on **September 25, 2024**, at **9:30 A.M.** Due to an ongoing construction project impacting TCEQ's meeting spaces, the agenda meeting will be held in **Room 244 of the Texas Workforce Commission** located at 101 East 15th Street in Austin, Texas, virtually, or both in person and virtually. 30 TAC § 80.263 provides as follows:

In proceedings where a judge has held a public hearing and has issued a proposal for decision or other report to the Commission, all oral presentations before the Commission shall be limited to five minutes each, excluding time for answering questions, unless the Chairman or General Counsel establishes other limitations. Before the Commission meeting, the General Counsel may allot time for oral presentations. Oral presentations and responses to questions shall be directed to the Commission.

The General Counsel has directed me to extend the time for oral argument to **eight (8) minutes** for the Applicant, **eight (8) minutes** for the Protestants collectively, **five (5) minutes** for the Executive Director; and **five (5) minutes** for the Office of Public Interest Counsel. *The Protestants should apportion their eight (8) minutes among themselves prior to the public meeting and contact Georgia Carroll-Warren, Office of the Chief Clerk at (512) 239-3300 by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 20, 2024, to let her know how the time will be apportioned.* The Applicant may save part of its time for rebuttal, as it bears the burden of proof. Parties should present their arguments on the Proposal for Decision during their allotted oral argument time.
